The Committee on Duplication of Courses presented the following new courses which were approved:

Physics 120. X-Ray Technique. Prerequisites: Physics 1a and 1b.
 Lectures and recitation two hours per week, one semester. Two credits.

- ✓ Physics 121a. Seminar on Classical Physics. Prerequisites: six credits in college Physics. Two hours a week. Two credits.
- ✓ Physics 121b. Seminar on Classical Physics. Continuation of Physics 121a. Prerequisite: Six credits in College physics. Two hours a week. Two credits.
- ✓ Political Science 165. World Politics. Three credits. (To replace Political Science 165a, b, same title, three credits per semester).
- ✓ Political Science 164. Foreign Service and International Relations. Three hours per week. Three credits. (To replace Political Science 160, American Foreign Service, and Political Science 161, International Organization, three credits each).
- ✓ English 133. Reference and Bibliography. Three hours a week. Three credits. (To replace English 133, Reference and Bibliography, two hours a week, two credits).
- ✓ English 144. Library Records and Methods. Two hours a week, two credits.
- ✓ Chemistry 207a. Systematic Inorganic Chemistry. Lectures and conferences, two hours a week. Two credits. Prerequisite: Chemistry 131b or equivalent.
- ✓ Chemistry 207b. Systematic Inorganic Chemistry. Continuation of Chemistry 207a. Lectures and conferences, two hours a week. Two credits.

The following courses were approved, with the understanding that the number of the courses were to be adjusted by the Dean of the College, the Head of the Department and the Registrar:

- ✓ English 127a and 127b. Literature of the Bible. Three hours a week. Three credits each semester. (To replace English 127a and 127b, Literature of the Bible. Two hours a week, two credits each semester).
- ✓ English 150. Book Selection for High School Teachers. Three hours a week. Three credits. (To replace English 150, Book Selection for High School Teachers, two hours a week, two credits.)

The following course was referred to the Committee with power to approve it after the content of the course is submitted:

- ✓ English 210. Seminar Bibliography. Two hours a week. Two credits. (For graduate students)

The following recommendation from the College of Education was approved:

"The faculty of the College of Education recommends that no student while doing his practice teaching in the field of general education shall carry more than sixteen semester hours including his practice teaching, and in the field of vocational education not more than eighteen semester hours including his practice teaching. The Committee on Scholarship and Attendance has no power to modify this regulation." (See minutes of Oct. 12, 1931)

The election of Senate representatives on the University Council was held and Messrs. J. C. Jones and J. E. Adams were elected for one year and W. E. Freeman and E. S. Good were elected for two years.
