Object of meeting, to receive signed charges against Cadets Freeman, Seales, Mason and Seppenfield. Charge brought by Col. Phelps that the above Cadets were found drinking on or about February 20th in their quarters. The charges having already been examined into by the Board of Discipline and the accused having plead guilty it was ^{resolved} ~~proposed~~ to concur in the sentence as proposed by the B. o. D. Sentence: To take a pledge in the presence of the Faculty to abstain from the use of all liquors of any kind or description while students of the State College, to be confined within the limits of the fence surrounding the College grounds for sixty days forfeiting all Cadet privileges in regard to visiting town, theatre etc. to be confined to their respective rooms from Friday evening to Monday morning for eight successive Saturdays and Sundays and to attend all drills, incl. Squad Drills until June 1st 1886. In case of violation of any of these conditions the offender to stand dismissed from College without further trial.
