Congressman John St. Wood, chairman of the House Committee on Un-American Activities, has recently asked the president of this University to supply a list of textbooks and supplementary readings used in course on this campus, for the inspection of his committee. In complying with this request, President Donovan voiced an impatience and as sense of outrage with the committee's tactics. There is no possible way your committee can determine how textbook material will be used in a classroom." "If a professor wishes to teach communism, he is not likely to rely upon textbooks anyhow."

If the Un-American Activities Committee and its ilk are allowed to continue in what seems to be a calculated design to discredit educators generally, we shall end up with a society as intellectually sterile as the Un-American Activities Committee used.
