At three o'clock P.M. the faculty was called to order by Vice Pres. Shockleford, and the report of the committee on the change of the present method of awarding honors was called for. Prof. Roark in behalf of the committee stated that they stood unanimously in favor of no change - On motion of Prof. W. K. Patterson, the report was adopted and the Committee discharged -
