

MINUTES OF THE UNIVERSITY FACULTY MEETING, OCTOBER 28, 1959

The University Faculty met in the Assembly Room of Lafferty Hall, Wednesday, October 28, at 4:00 P. M. with 47 members present. President Dickey presided. Roll was not taken since the meeting was called at a time when many of the Faculty members were scheduled for classes.

The minutes of October 12 were read and approved.

Names of candidates for degrees whose work was completed August 3, were presented by the Dean of Admissions and Registrar, who certified that all had completed their requirements and had been recommended by their respective Deans. An explanation was made that the special meeting was called because of the requests of students who desired approval of degrees in order to hold positions they had secured. Dean Spivey asked if the names of the candidates for degrees approved at this meeting would be included in the list of candidates in the June Commencement Program. It was the consensus that the names of the candidates for degrees in August and January should be included within the June Commencement Program. The University Faculty approved a motion to recommend all candidates to the Board of Trustees for the degrees indicated.
