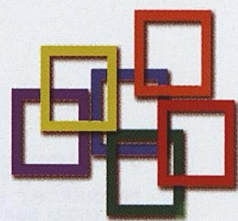
On behalf of the Commonwealth, I am pleased to welcome you to the Bluegrass.

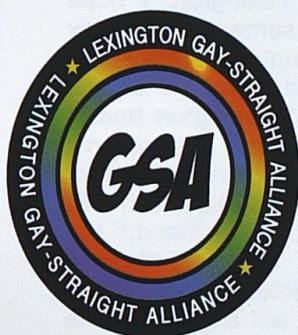

Brief GLSO Timeline

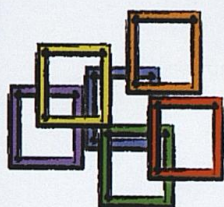
- 1977 GLSO is formed
- 1980 Involved in filling social service gaps and gay stigmas regarding the HIV epidemic
- 1982 Sponsored first annual Pride Picnic
- 1983 Received 501(c)(3) status from the IRS
- 1986 The word "Lesbian" was added to the name to recognize important roles of female leaders
- 1993 Stonewall Network began working on raising funds to create a Pride Center
- 1996 The GLSO Pride Center opens
- 2008 The GLSO presents the first Lexington Pride Festival
