Musicologist Lectures:

On Wednesday, 13 April, in the Gallery, Dr. Otto Albrecht (professor of music, University of Pennsylvania) will lecture on "The search for music manuscripts in the United States." The lecture is sponsored by the UK School of Music and is open to the public. Dr. Albrecht is an authority on German song, music in the US to 1860, and music bibliography. He is currently preparing a revised edition of his book, A census of autograph music manuscripts of European composers in American Libraries.
