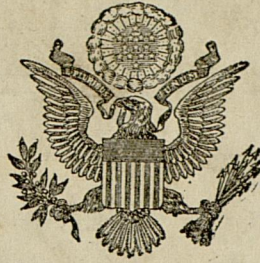


# Honorable Discharge from the Army of the United States
