• The region's park system has been designed to break up suburban development with frequent strips of green; to utilize submarginal land; and to protect main roads from string building. The chief open spaces -- the Maryland State Forest, Fort Meade, and the National Research Center -- will be linked together by the proposed parkway. They may be supplemented by a state park and forest preserve, to be developed on submarginal land between Fort Meade and the Research Center. Since the greenbelt town lies along the parkway, it will have ready access to all recreation areas.
