WATER FACILITIES Gravity system of water works. Supply from Kentucky River. Water pumped to two reservoirs, located on hill, 287 ft. above High Street one mile West of city limits, capacity 3 million gallons each. 17 million gallons supply in reservoirs at all times. One daily Compound Duplex pump - 3 million gallons capacity, and one four duplex pump, 12 million gallons capacity per 24 hours. 4 Boilers, 100 ft. each. 14 Miles of water pipes 4 to 16 diam. 110 Double hydrants. Pressure 120 lbs. per sq. inch. 15 Fire cisterns average capacity 1000 barrels.

FIRE DEPARTMENT Fully paid men - all sleep in fire station, three horses, carrying harness, conventional fire alarm system, 20 boxes. One third class Molineux steam fire engine in reserve. One hook & ladder truck and hose wagon combined, 30 ft. of ladders in use. Three hose wagons carrying 1000 ft. of hose, 1800 ft. cotton rubber lined hose, 800 ft. of which is new. 4 Drains and 2 shut-off nozzles. 4 Cooper hose clamps, 6 buckets, 7 axes.

# INSURANCE MAP OF Frankfort KENTUCKY

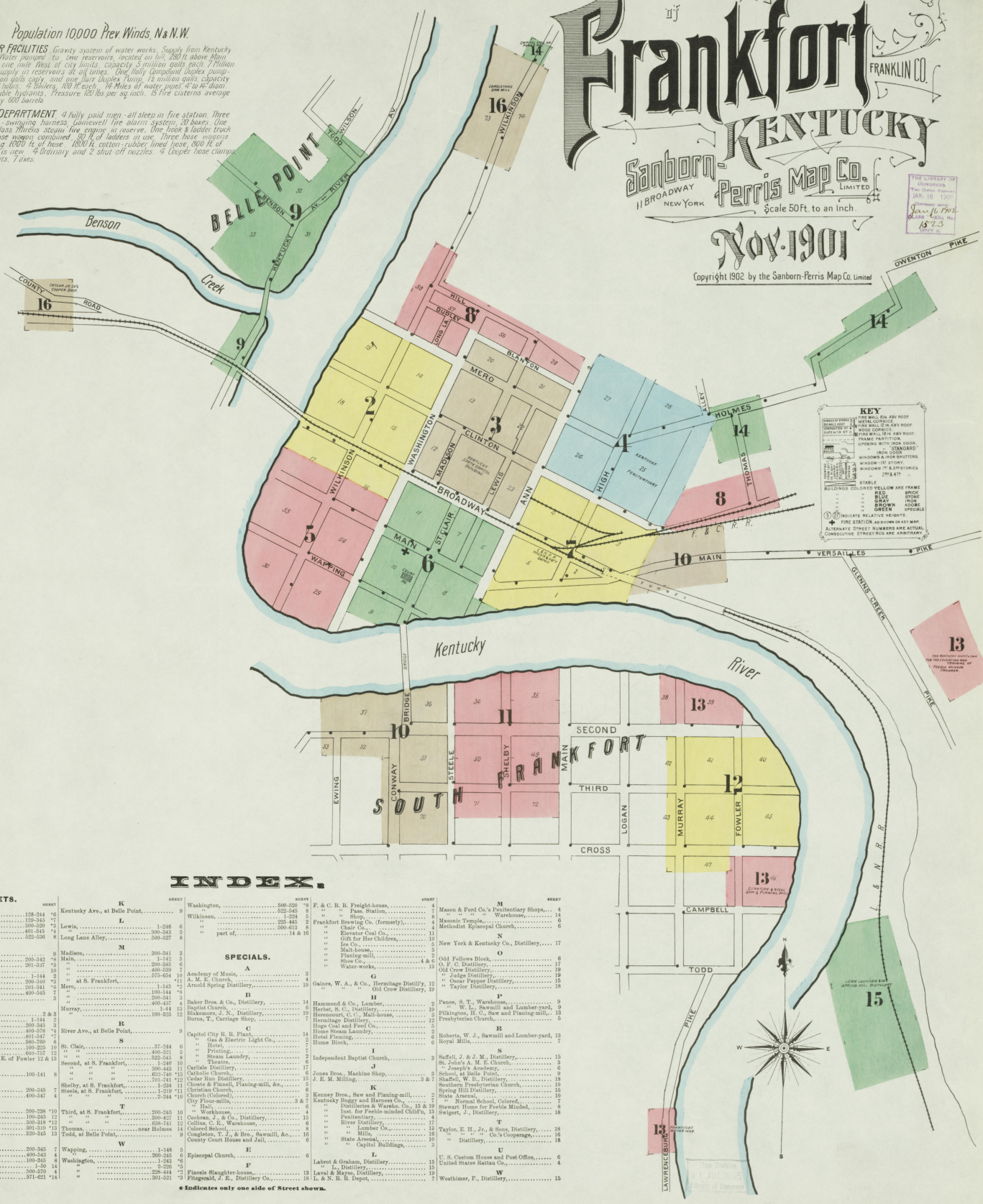
