

"Rosewood"

July 11th 1868.

My dear Mother,

I arrived here safely on Thursday evening at half past seven. Alice W. and Sida Ginn met me at the boat. He & Ginn was there also. We came out here right from the boat, did not visit Vin town for supper, though they wanted us to do so.

I suppose Brother told you that primary Paunday was on the boat. I had the pleasure of his company most of the afternoon. He was very attentive, went to dinner with me, and was ^{very} particular about seeing me off the boat, went off with me. I introduced him to Alice and Sida. He was on his way to Springfield, Ky. to see his sister and other relatives. He knows Sue Hughes, and Lily Hunt, & is very well, so that I sent some messages by him to them.
