The following new courses were recommended by the College of Education and were authorized, subject to the approval of the Committee on Duplication:

Education 238 - Trends in Higher Education. This course will survey modern tendencies in American higher education in the following areas: scope and development, objectives, organization, administration, curricula, finance, and faculty and student personnel. It is designed to serve the needs of present and prospective college administrators and teachers and others interested in developments in higher education. For those desiring special instruction in the work of the registrar a program of laboratory work will be arranged. Lectures and recitations. 3 credits.

Education 276 - Administrative Problems in Today's Education. This course has to do with present day problems of persons in administrative positions in public education. It is designed to be of assistance particularly to superintendents of schools. 3 credits.

The College of Education also recommended that Education 266a,b Seminar in Home Economics Education, 6 credits, be raised to Education 266a,b,c, 9 credits. This recommended change was approved.
