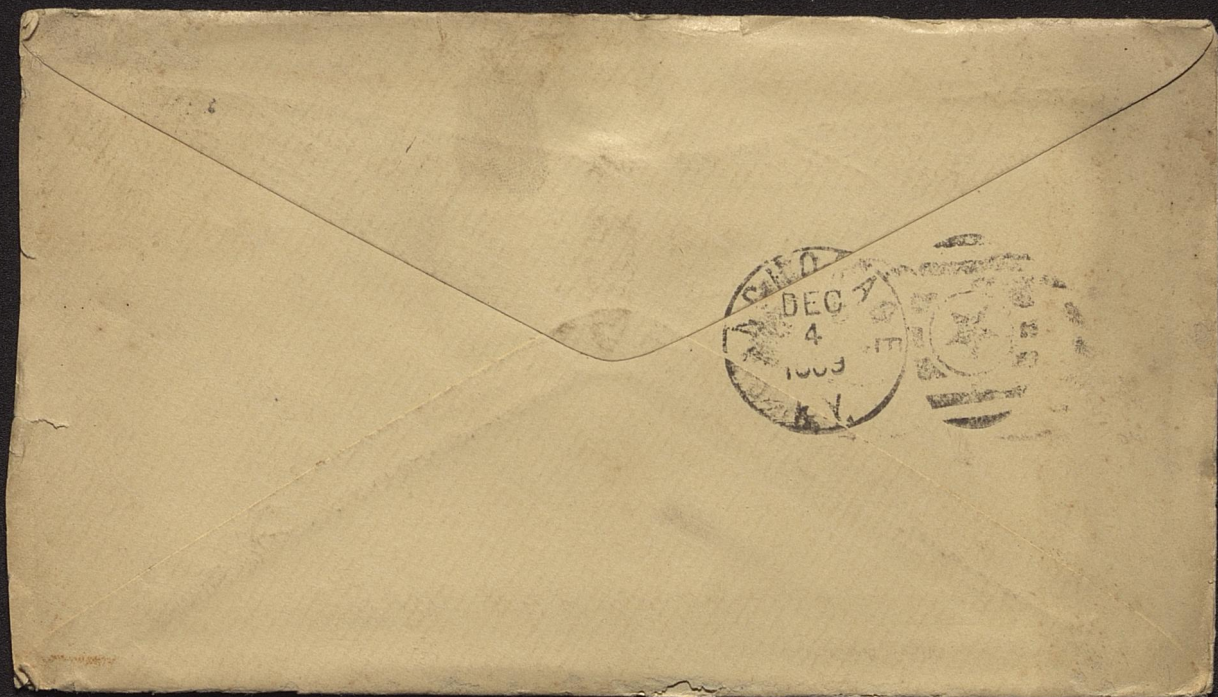

Dear Bro Badinger

Indeed I am already behind on my necessary expenses through going to Logrange & Westport - at ~~the~~ which latter place we have lost surely recently by death & removal though Rev. Jacob still continues his contributions. I merely mention the matter now, hoping that in the distribution of funds the Com. will take this work field into consideration.

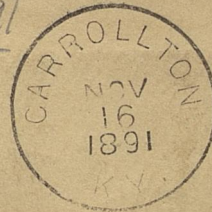
