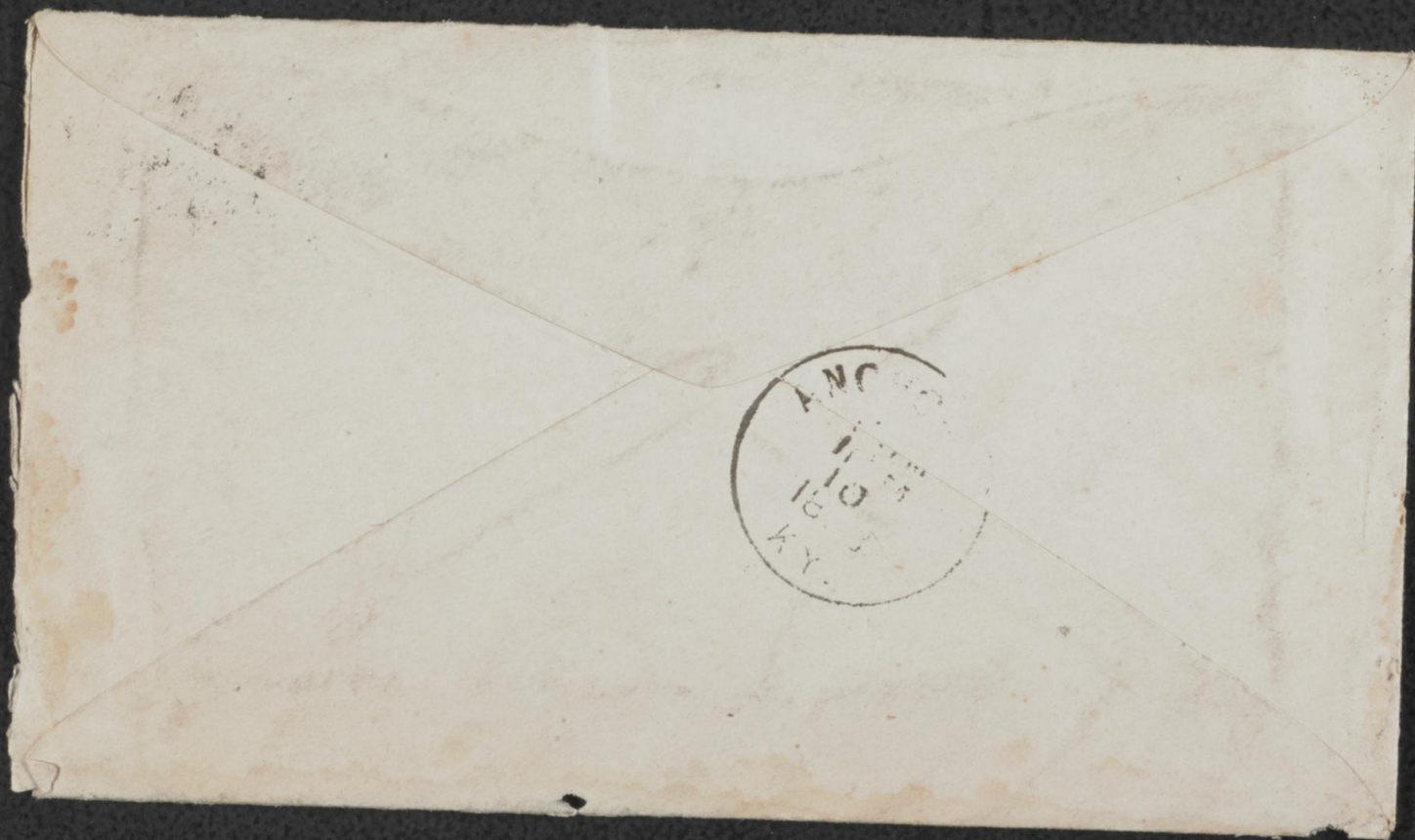

the relation between me and Maxwell
St ch. The 1st church of Lexington say
that after this year, ending May 1st 1894
they can extend us aid to Maxwell, the
little church can raise about \$700⁰⁰
and need \$300⁰⁰ more to secure a preacher
of experience, no boy is needed or desired if
it can be avoided. Your Com: could
not be, on the present year, asked for
help, except from ¹⁸⁹⁴ May to Oct 94, ^{about} \$150⁰⁰

You recognize the importance of Maxwell
St. and, if your Com: will have a
meeting soon could you present it?
I am not authorized by any one to
present the matter but act entirely on
my own judgment and in view of
a crisis in the affairs of the Church.
If you could correspond with Mr
J. J. Forman he can give you all
information desired.

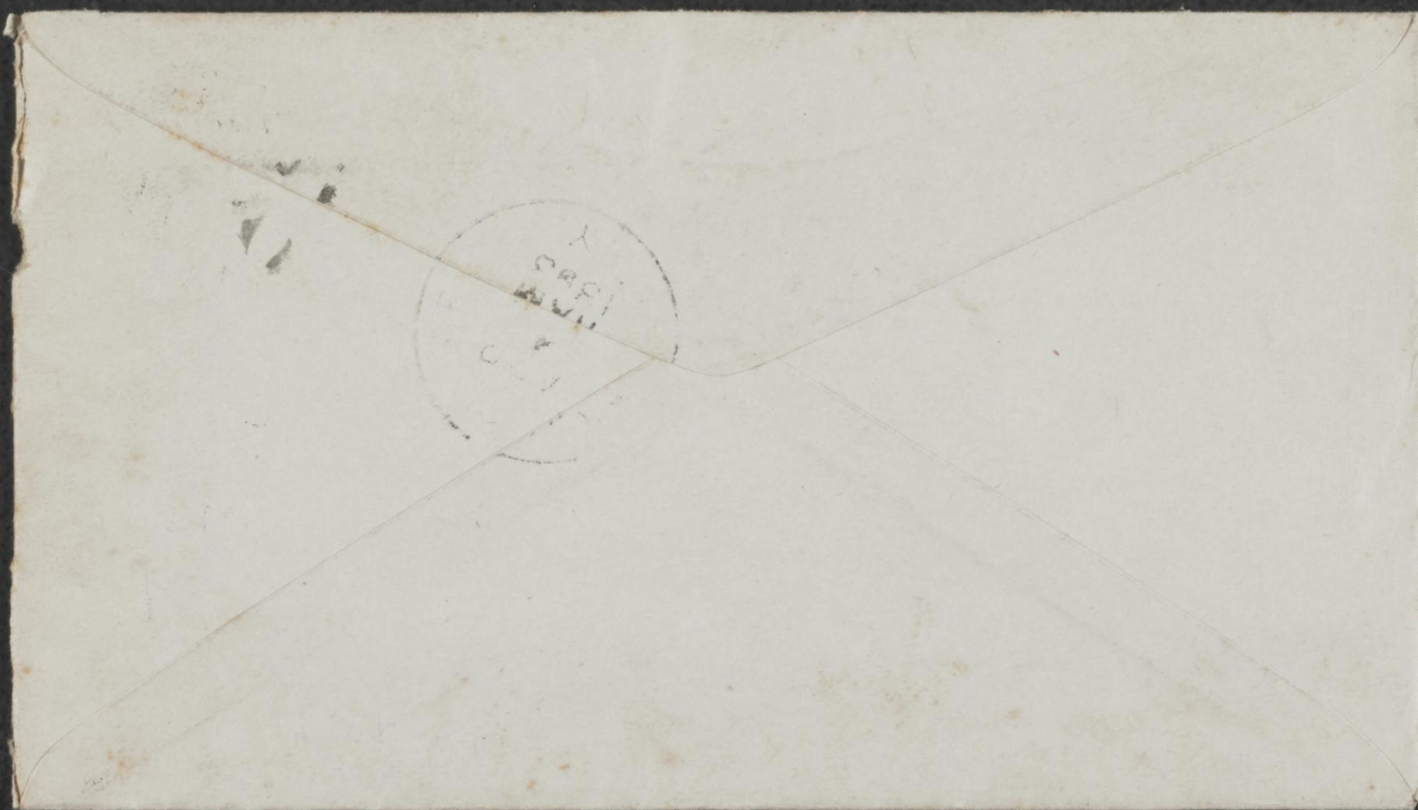

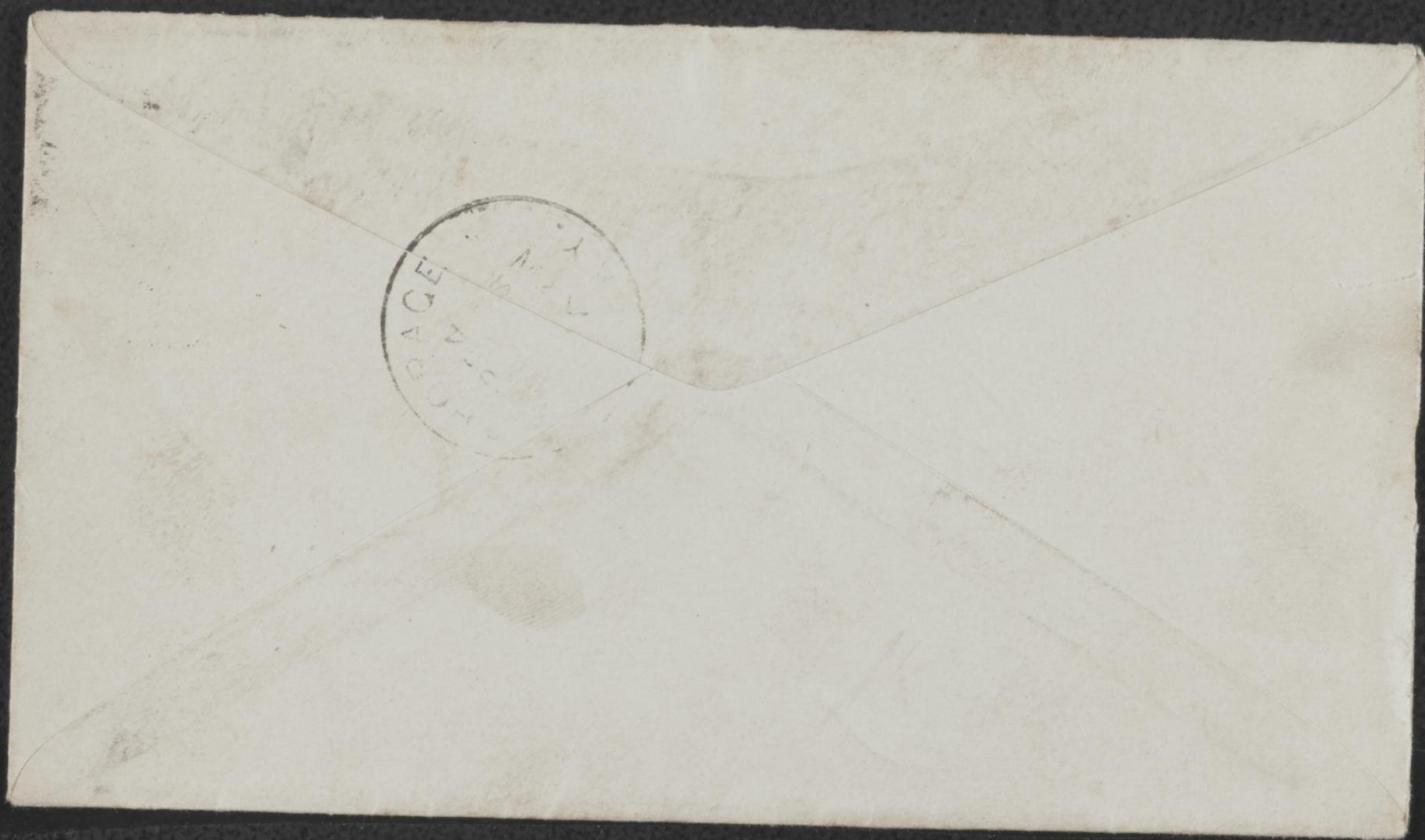

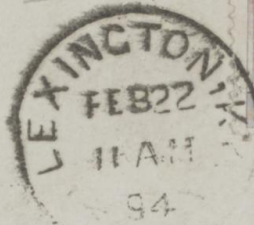
I enclose you check

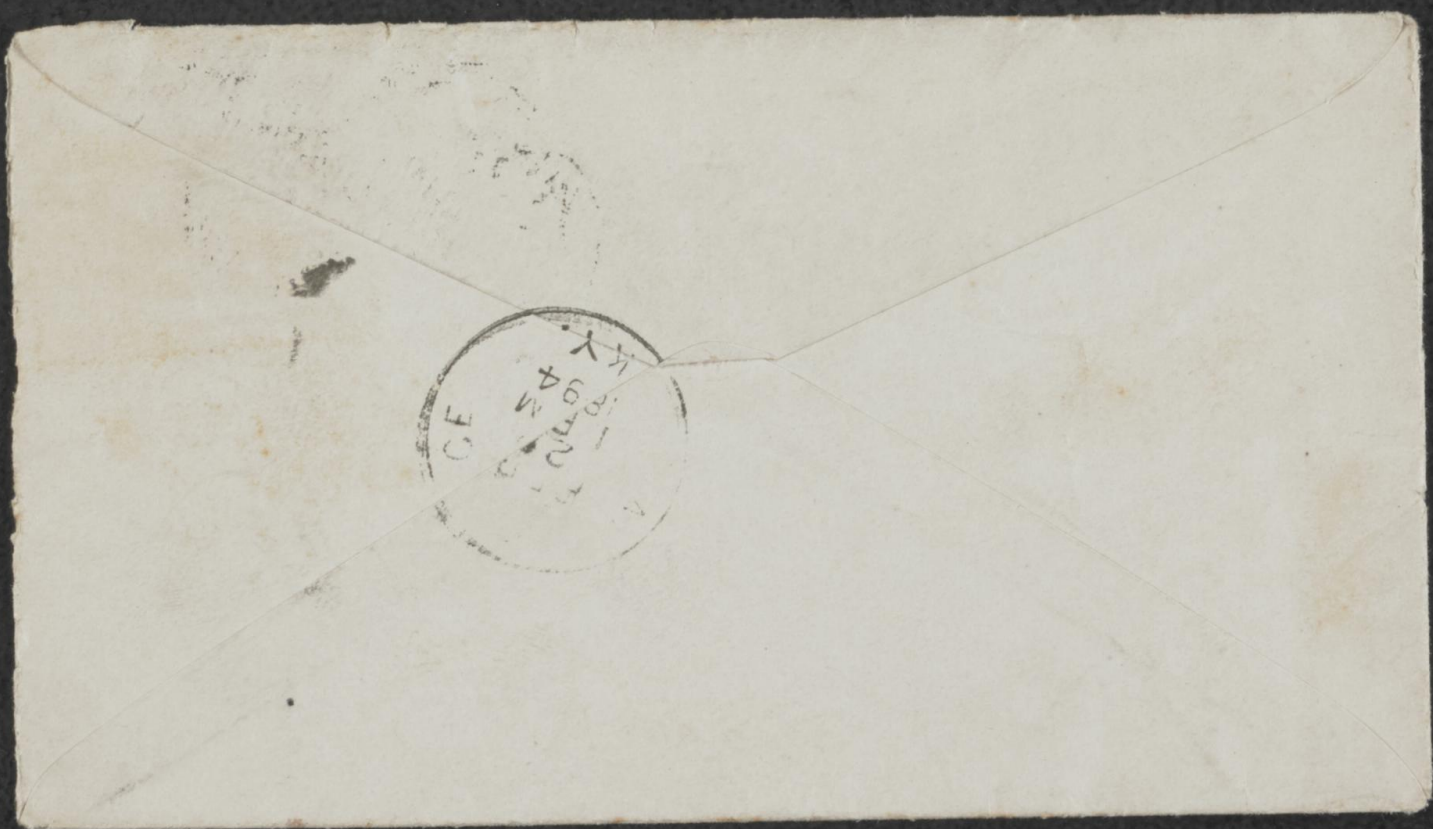

My dear Mr. Bedinger.

It was not my intention to do you or any one of the Com: an injustice. The facts, however, are these. Bro. Hopper had been "leading" in meetings at various times and with many members of the Com: present or participating in his meetings. He has had the quasi endorsement or permission of the Com: in his "irregular" position and work. I had never heard of any one objecting to the position he assumed or the work done. If you have made the protest, I did you wrong in including you with the others and now as far as possible retract any offensive words. But as a member of the Com:, you must admit that the Com: have and are continuing a lay brother at the front of the evangelistic effort. The responsibility rests somewhere and upon the Com:, it appears to most of us who understand. I can't see how he receives authority - if not from the Com:.

and if the Com: know what he is doing and no protest is made from them, they can expect people to judge them as acquiescing in his method of work. You place it upon the pastors but they only allow Stopper to work his own way as he has done elsewhere. He is the agent of the Com: and if the individual members are not responsible, they surely are as a Com: If you are overruled, you can only submit.

Your closing statement about "resigning" has no bearing upon the point under discussion. I did not make ^{in paper,} any reply to your card because, I have no desire or time for such a "warfare". My card was to you personally and the matter will end there.

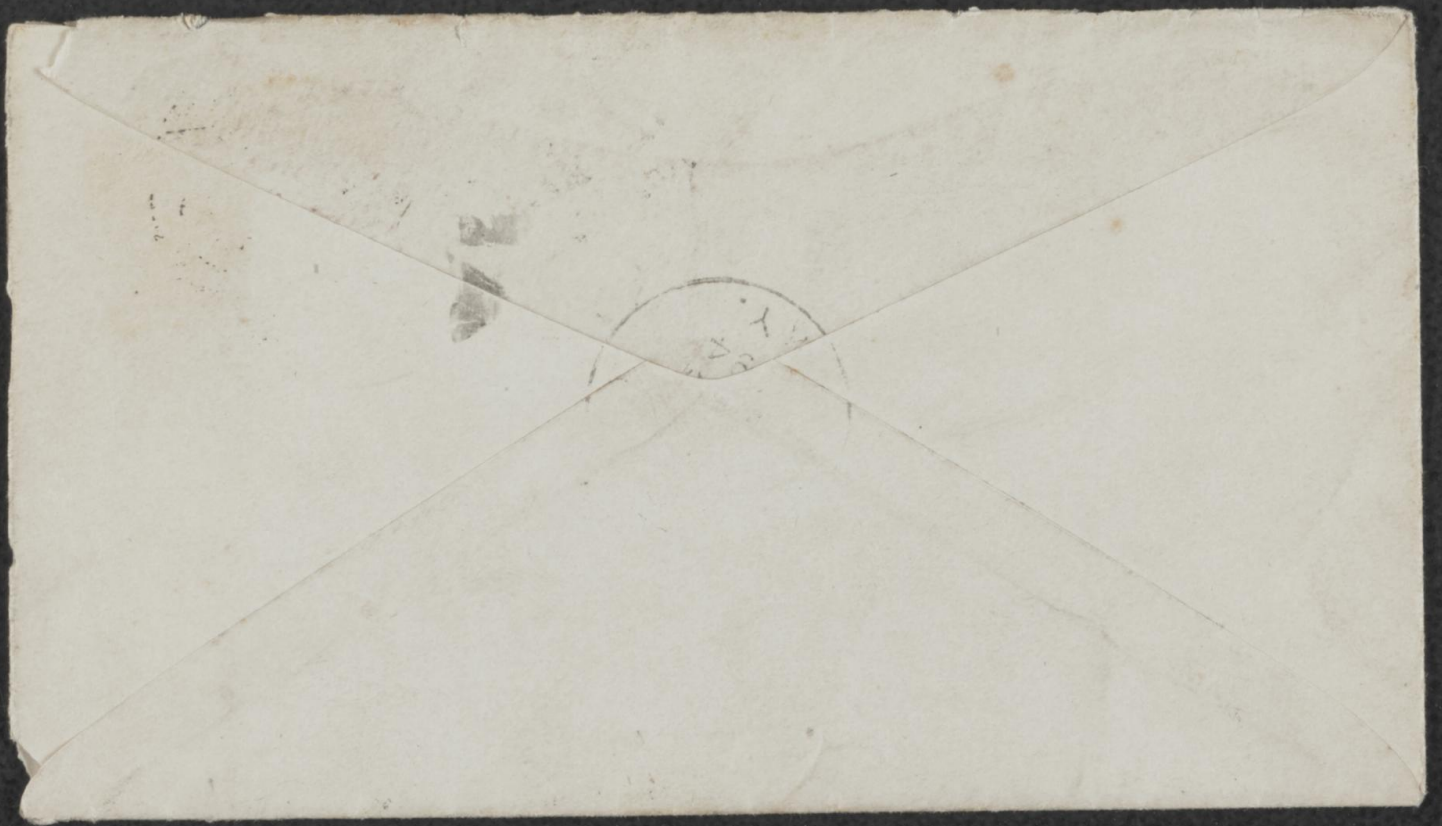
