### ANALYSES OF COMMERCIAL FERTILIZERS

This bulletin presents the results of the inspection of commercial fertilizers sold in Kentucky during the calendar year, 1938. The 652 brands registered for sale in the State are classified as follows:

Mixed fertilizers containing nitrogen, phosphoric acid and potash .....	422 brands
Mixed fertilizers containing phosphoric acid and potash .....	49 brands
Mixed fertilizers containing nitrogen and phosphoric acid .....	14 brands
Superphosphates .....	60 brands
Bones, tankage, etc. ....	42 brands
Nitrogen salts .....	40 brands
Potash salts .....	25 brands

A total of 1,031 samples were analyzed of which 715 were taken by inspectors, 230 were sent by manufacturers to represent fertilizers sold in the State and 86 were sent by county agents, farmers and others. The inspection samples may be classified as follows:

Samples containing nitrogen, phosphoric acid and potash .....	482
Samples containing phosphoric acid and potash .....	48
Samples containing nitrogen and phosphoric acid.....	23
Superphosphates .....	151
Nitrogen salts .....	10
Potash salts .....	1

A tag is required to be placed on each bag of fertilizer, before it is sold or offered for sale, on which the following information is printed:

Name of fertilizer  
Name and address of manufacturer  
Guaranteed minimum analysis  
    Nitrogen, percent  
    Available phosphoric acid, percent  
    Potash, from muriate or sulfate, percent  
    Estimated value per 100 lbs.

Total phosphoric acid, in place of available phosphoric acid, is guaranteed in bone and tankage. At the bottom of the tag must be placed a stamp on which is printed the net weight of fertilizer in the package and authorization of its sale by the Director, over his facsimile signature. The estimated value is for the purpose of comparing the values of fertilizers of different grades and should not be confused with the selling price. This cannot be accurately estimated because of the many factors, some of them variable, which are included in it.

The estimated value is determined by giving arbitrary values to the ingredients and calculating the corresponding values per 100 pounds or per ton. The values used are:

Nitrogen .....	17.5	3.5
Available phosphoric acid in mixed fertilizers and in superphosphate .....	6.0	1.2
Total phosphoric acid in bone .....	5.0	1.0
Potash in all fertilizers .....	6.0	1.2

A unit is 20 pounds or 1 percent of a ton. If the unit value for each ingredient is multiplied by the percent of the ingredient in the fertilizer and all the results are added, the relative commercial value per ton, or index of relative value, is obtained. This valuation is used in comparing the value of samples analyzed with manufacturers' guarantees. The valuation depends upon the actual content of fertilizer ingredients and should not be confused with the crop producing value nor with the selling price of the fertilizer.

Potash .....	$4 \times 1.2$ equals 4.8

#### EXPLANATION OF THE TABLES

The analyses of all samples which are considered satisfactory are found in Table I. Analyses in Table II are considered unsatisfactory, either because the estimated value is too low or because some ingredient is too low. The figures in bold-face type

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are those results which are considered too low to be acceptable. Sometimes the same brand will be found in both tables, in which case it is marked in each table with a (†) dagger. Ground bone was also analyzed mechanically by sifting on a sieve with holes 1 millimeter (.04 inch) in diameter. "Fine bone" is that which passed thru this sieve; "medium bone" is that which was retained on the sieve.

**INFORMATION CONCERNING THE USE OF FERTILIZERS**

Those interested in the use of fertilizers for different crops should apply to the College of Agriculture, the Experiment Station, or to their County Agents, and such literature as bears on the subject in which they are interested will be sent them.
