The Faculty met at the usual time and place. Permission to change their boarding was granted to Messrs Chatham, Handley, and Carrwell. For disorderly conduct the general conduct of Messrs. Button, Milam, Webster, Mollineaux, and Beal was reduced 10 of each and that of Messrs Thebault and Wilson, 15 of. Britton was allowed to withdraw. The request of Mr. Morgan to be excused from military duty was referred to Maj. Lutton. The Secretary was directed to write to the guardian of Mr. Ramsey, requesting his withdrawal. Messrs Ellis and Watterton were dismissed for repeated disorder and neglect of duties. Bateman was reported for having refused to attend his examinations. It was resolved that he be privately reprimanded. The Secretary was directed to request the Regent to write to Elbow's Mother requiring his withdrawal.
