The meeting was called to order by President Barker and the minutes of the last meeting read and approved.

Taking up the regular order of business, Lieut. Gullion,
on behalf of the Military Committee, stated that he had
received a communication from the War Department, request- professional desired the market of the state of the st

and he described the military Department of the University be granted one whole afternoon some time during April in which to have some training out in the country.

The motion was made, seconded and carried, that this request be granted.

The subject of Commencement Exercises was next considered. President Barker stated that the Alumni were anxious to keep the students here during Commencement week, and, to this end, a special baseball game had been arranged between the Faculty and the 'Varsity, as one feature of entertainment.

A special committee, composed of Prof. Miller,
Dr. Terrell, Dean Hamilton, Lieut. Gullion and Prof.Roberts,
was appointed to formulate further plans for entertainment
during Commencement week, and report at the next meeting.

The question was asked by Dr. Kastle whether/, as in the case of two young men, W.G. and G.A. Smith, having conditions in Descriptive Geometry, could change to another college without having these conditions count against them in graduation.

Motion was made by Prof. Anderson that if the subject in which the student was conditioned was not required in the college to which he was transferred, the failure should not be held against him.

This motion was seconded and carried.

Dr. Tuthill introduced the question of the University owning a United States flag. After some discussion a committee composed of Prof. Melcher, Lieut. Gullion and Dr. Tuthill, was appointed to ascertain the cost. etc., and report at the next meeting.

Mr. Gillis asked to be advised with reference to the disposal of \$7.50 belonging to members of the Monday Club.

On motion made, seconded and unanimously carried, this sum was placed at the disposal of the Flag Committee.

On motion, the meeting adjourned.
