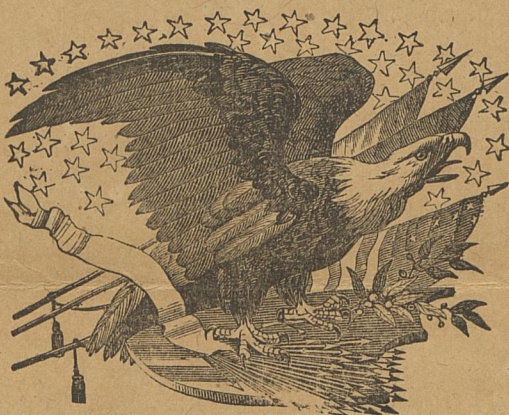


To all whom it may Concern

Company, ( ) Regiment of Kentucky Infantry  
VOLUNTEERS who was enrolled on the Eighth day of April  
one thousand eight hundred and Sixty five to serve One years or  
during the war, is hereby **Discharged** from the service of the United States,  
this Fifteenth day of September, 1865, at Louisville  
Kentucky by reason of Special Orders, U.S. Army, No. 25, 1865  
(No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.)\*

Light hair, and by occupation, when enrolled, a Soldier
