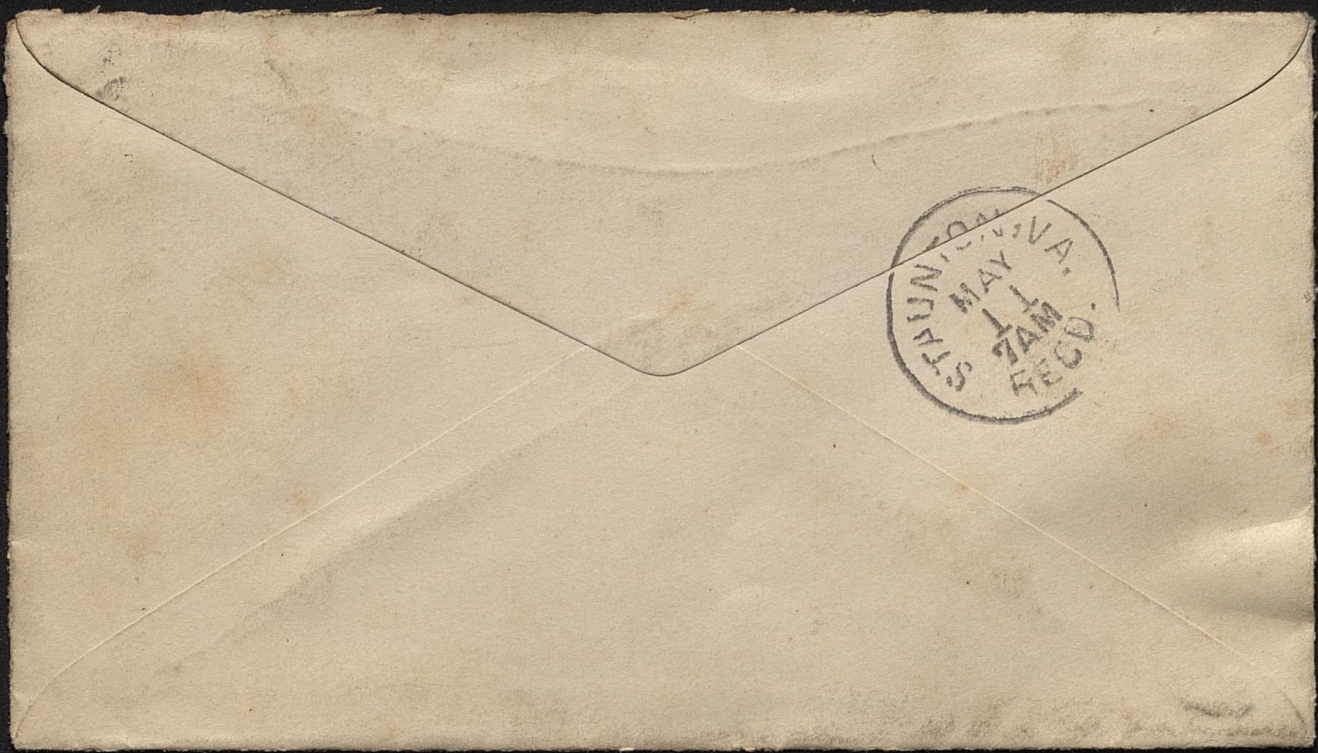

upon writ of error and supersedeas to a judgment rendered by the  
circuit court of the county of Amherst, on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of August 1887.

This cause which is pending in this court at its place of session at Staunton, having been fully heard but not determined at said place of session, this day came here again the parties by their counsel, and the court having maturely considered the transcript of the record of the judgment aforesaid and the arguments of counsel is of opinion, for reasons stated in writing and filed with the record that the said judgment is erroneous; it is therefore considered that the same be reversed and annulled and that the plaintiffs in error recover of the defendant in error their costs by them expended, in the prosecution of their writ of error aforesaid here - And this court proceeding to render such judgment, as the said circuit court ought to have rendered, it is further considered that all the proceedings in the cause subsequent to the rendition of the first verdict in the proceedings mentioned be set aside and annulled; and it is further considered that the paper writing dated August 18. 1884, in the proceedings mentioned, is not the true last will and testament of the said William Tucker deceased.

And it is further considered that the plaintiffs in error here do recover of the defendant in error their costs by them expended in the said circuit court of Amherst county in this proceeding.

Which is ordered to be entered in the order book here, and forthwith certified to the clerk of this court at Staunton, who shall enter the same in his order book, and certify it to the said circuit

court of the county of Amherst

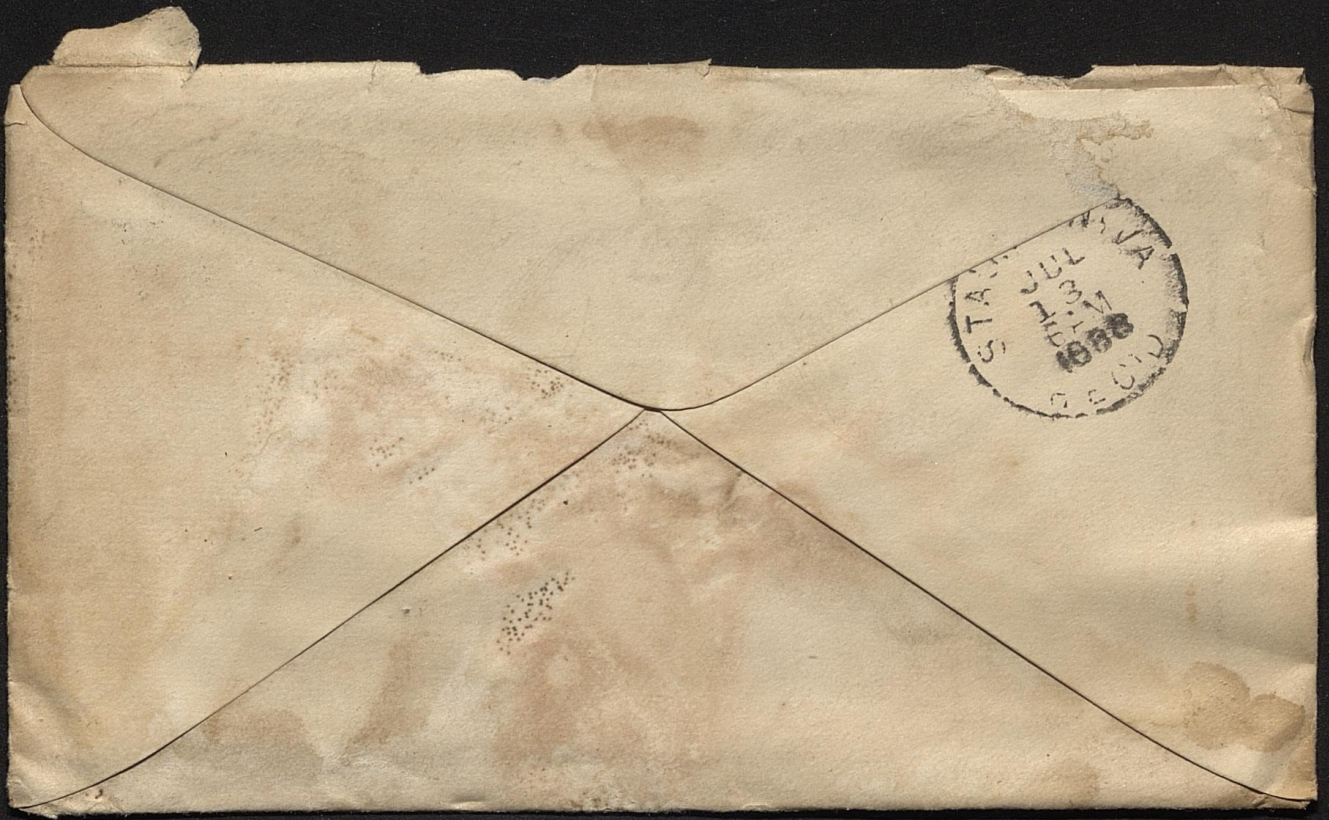
