County and State of Virginia am held and firmly bound unto Wm
Mecke of Fayette County and District of Kentucky in the just
and full sum of two hundred pounds Lawfull Money of the State
Aforesaid to be paid unto the said Wm Mecke his certain Heir
Heirs Executors Adm^{rs} to which payment well and truly to be
made I bind my selfe my heirs Executors Adm^{rs} firmly by these
presents seal with my seal and dated this 9th day of April
ten hundred & Eighty Eight

The Condition of the Above obligation is such that if the Above
bound Person shall well and truly make or cause to
be made to the said Wm Mecke his Heirs a good and just Deed in
fee simple to the halfe of a six hundred & forty acre tract of Land
which I Moore have John Donelson's obligation for the Land
is to lye on the waters of Stones River a branch of the
S^d tract to be divided as Equally in quantity and Quality as
Possible. but if I Moore should not recover S^d tract of Land
of S^d Donelson but Value, I Mecke is not to see for S^d Land
but for halfe the value recovered. The Deed to be made as soon
as I Moore obtains a right from S^d Donelson
Then the Above obligation to be void & the same to remain
in full force and Virtue in law
