

IROQUOIS POLO TEAM TRIUMPHS

PITTSBURGH, May 29 (AP)—The Iroquois Polo Club of Lexington, Ky., toppled the Pittsburgh riders today, 6-4.

The southerners' victory deadlocks the three-game series at one each. The "rubber" game will be played Monday.

The victors scored in the first chukker when Clay Simpson slashed the pellet 60 yards to the goal. It was a free shot, resulting from a Pittsburgh foul by Jim Crowdon, who narrowly escaped injury in the second period when his pony tumbled.

On a fresh steed, Crowdon immediately dribbled 50 yards for a tally.

Injection of Bliss Flaccus at the start of the third chukker failed to avert defeat for Pittsburgh.
