Add-drop session today begins school year

Add-drop will begin today in Memorial Coliseum for advance-registered students. And UK officials hope it will be the last time.

"If everything goes OK with the new computer system, Add-drop will be a thing of the past," said William Endorf, director of student records.

UK recently purchased a computer system that combines advance registration with Add-drop. The new process will enable students to advance register with the knowledge of what classes are open and receive their schedule immediately. The new system will begin this fall for the spring of 1989 registration.

Centralized Add-drop begins at 10 a.m. and will remain open until 6 p.m. Students will be admitted alphabetically in 30-minute increments.

"Commonly people go early thinking they can get in, but they can't," Endorf said.

When students arrive during

their allotted time, they will be given an entry card to enter the coliseum. They also will receive Add-drop slips and a map showing where each college is located.

Students must bring a photo ID, No. 2 lead pencils and their registration slip. The ROTC will provide students with copies of their registration slips near the east side of the concourse.

"Always add before you drop," said Randall Dahl, UK registrar.

"If you drop a class before you add, you may end up in a bad position. It is helpful to consult your adviser about changing classes.

"You have to be very careful about

taking advice from other students because what works for one student may not work for another."

With the increase in enrollment this year, Dahl recommended that students drop the classes they do not intend to take as soon as possible.

Dahl said students should go to Add-drop with an open mind and be patient. He also said students should turn in their cards to the appropriate college desk before leaving to ensure their place in class.

For more information, students may see representatives at the information desk at Add-drop, or call the registrar's office at 257-7173.

Other important dates to remember:

• Tuesday is the last day to officially drop a course or cancel registration in writing with the registrar for a full refund of fees.



• Wednesday is the first day of class work.

• Aug. 24-30 is late registration for returning students who did not advance register and new applicants cleared late for admission. Continuing students and graduate students register in their college deans' offices. New undergraduate students register in the Undergraduate Admissions Office, 100 Funkhouser Building.

Undergraduate students, who were canceled for non-payment of \$50 confirmation fee, begin in 207 Gillis Building. Canceled graduate students begin in the Graduate School.

A \$40 late fee is assessed to students who register late. Students should return completed late registration forms to 207 Gillis Building.

UK sports had both good, bad

While the NCAA's investigation into the UK basketball program held the spotlight for much of the summer, UK's sports program remained busy on all playing fields.

The only thing that had UK basketball fans more upset than the outcome of the NCAA investigation was the defection of state demi-god Rex Chapman.

The star guard, who led the Cats in scoring each of his first two years, threw his name into the National Basketball Association's June 28 draft. Chapman was the eighth pick in the first round by the Charlotte Hornets.

Chapman, 20, called the move "strictly a business decision."

Fellow Wildcats Rob Lock, Winston Bennett and Ed Davender also were drafted, but none as high as Chapman. Lock recently signed a six-figure salary to play his brand of basketball in Italy.

"Rex Chapman signifies everything the franchise stands for," said Charlotte Vice President Carl Scheer. "That is, youth, excitement, explosiveness, talent. I think we started with a great young player."

As it turned out, Chapman would soon be joined on the absent-without-leave list by UK recruits Sean Woods and Shawn Kemp. Both were declared academically ineligible for the 1988-89 season.

The news could get worse. Chris Mills, a freshman forward from California, could be ineligible pending the outcome of the NCAA investigation.

But while UK's basketball team might want everyone to forget what has happened, you can see the Kentucky basketball team has just the opposite view.

In late May, UK baseball coach Keith Madison led his baseball Wildcats to a 2nd-place SEC finish, and guided them to the NCAA tournament for the first time in more than 38 years. Only eventual titlist Stanford got in the way of a World Series berth.

Madison wasn't the only coach on campus smiling. Dennis Emery, who brought Kentucky from obscurity to a national power, led UK to one of its best seasons of tennis ever.

Led by the duo of Greg Van Emburgh and Richard Benson, Kentucky qualified for the NCAA tournament, racked up 23 victories. UK was eventually defeated in a close battle with Stanford.

UK women's basketball coach Sharon Fanning, determined to raise a few eyebrows, went out and signed 10 players to her 1988-89 Lady Kat team, including Lisa Ellis, the sister of UK center Lora Ellis.

The UK Athletic Association Board of Directors approved a \$13.7 million budget June 15 for the 1989 fiscal year — \$4 million more than last year. UK assistant athletic director Larry Ivy called it a "very representative budget."

News at University neglected to take summer vacation

Although most UK students took a break this summer, the news didn't.

A lot of the publicity UK received this summer centered on the NCAA investigation into the men's basketball program.

The investigation stems from a March 30 incident in which the Los Angeles Daily News reported that UK assistant men's basketball coach Dwane Casey sent a videotape and \$1,000 to Claud Mills, father of UK recruit Chris Mills, in an Emery overnight express package.

In a July 27 press conference, UK President David Roselle told reporters that a letter from David Berst, director of NCAA enforcement, said "it appears reasonable to expect" Casey sent the money to Mills.

In addition, Berst's letter told Roselle that UK should expect "approximately 10 other allegations" handed down from the NCAA by the beginning of September.

Earlier in the summer, Casey's attorney, Joe Bill Campbell, filed a \$6.9 million suit on behalf of the assistant coach against Emery, asking for punitive and compensatory damages.

In other news this summer:

• Faculty salaries didn't see any noticeable improvement in the \$614.3 million 1989 fiscal budget passed by the UK Board of Trustees.

The budget, which was approved by the BOT in June, provided for only a two-percent faculty and staff salary increase.

"We came far short of meeting the faculty and staff needs," said BOT member Larry Forgy.

• UK agreed to pay a black doctor, who had worked in the orthopedic surgery division, up to \$14,000 for alleged racial harassment he received while on the job.

Dr. Donald Douglas, a UK medical school graduate, alleged that while he was a resident at UK's Medical Center, he was harassed by other doctors because he was black. Douglas was the only black in his division.

UK denied there was discrimination, said Galin Martin, executive director of the Kentucky Human Rights Commission. But the University agreed to allow Douglas back on the staff and pay him up to \$14,000 — 12,000 in "lost time" and up to \$2,000 in travel expenses.

• Ray Hornback resigned as UK's vice president for University relations.

In June to take a position with The Preston Group Inc., a Lexington public-relations firm.

Hornback said he was sad to leave higher education but his new job was "a great challenge: an opportunity to do something different."

Hornback's position was not filled. Roselle said because of a tight budget Hornback's responsibilities would be split up and assigned to Charles Wethington, chancellor for the community college system, and Terry Mobley, director of development.

• On July 24, the former business manager of the medical department of the Medical Center pleaded guilty to embezzling \$35,121 from the UK hospital.

Frederick R. Herman, 41, admitted to taking federal payments that were due to UK and its doctors for performing black lung operations.

A September sentencing date has been set for Herman.

• UK budgeted \$30 million to renovate and expand the hospital portion of the medical center. The new hospital building will be connected to the existing parking garage.

• Former Kentucky Gov. A.B. "Happy" Chandler was one of four people appointed to the UK Athletic Association board of directors by Roselle in June.

Chandler, 90, was the subject of protests by students and UK athletes for a racial statement made at an April BOT finance committee meeting.

Chandler, however, said that he felt the incident had been "put to rest" long ago.

"I don't think I'll be castigated because of that moment," he said. "I'm going to serve (the University) as long as I'm above ground."

Wethington, Jerome Stricker and Forgy, both BOT members, also were appointed to the board.

• Former Kentucky Gov. A.B. "Happy" Chandler was one of four people appointed to the UK Athletic Association board of directors by Roselle in June.
