

This Indenture made the 31<sup>st</sup> day August  
1833 between Samuel Cox of the State of  
Missouri of the one part and Isham Brown  
of the County of Gallatin and State of  
Kentucky of the other part Witnesseth  
that for and in consideration of the  
sum of Two hundred dollars in hand  
paid the receipt whereof is hereby ac-  
knowledged hath granted bargained and  
sold unto the said Brown & certain tract  
of land lying on the waters of Big Sugar  
creek and bounded as follows beginning  
at two Beeches and black ash on the East  
bank of said creek thence South 20 West  
130 poles to a rock on said creek 3  
poles west of two sycamores marked thence  
N 70 West 6 1/2 poles to a beech and white  
Walnut on a hill side thence N 20 E 130  
poles to two beeches and elm on a hill side  
thence S 70 East 6 1/2 poles to the beginning  
Containing by survey fifty acres to have  
and to hold the land hereby conveyed  
with the appurtenances unto the said  
Brown his heirs and assigns forever and  
the said Samuel Cox for himself his  
heirs Executors and administrators the  
aforesaid tract of land and appurten-  
ances unto the said Brown his heirs and
