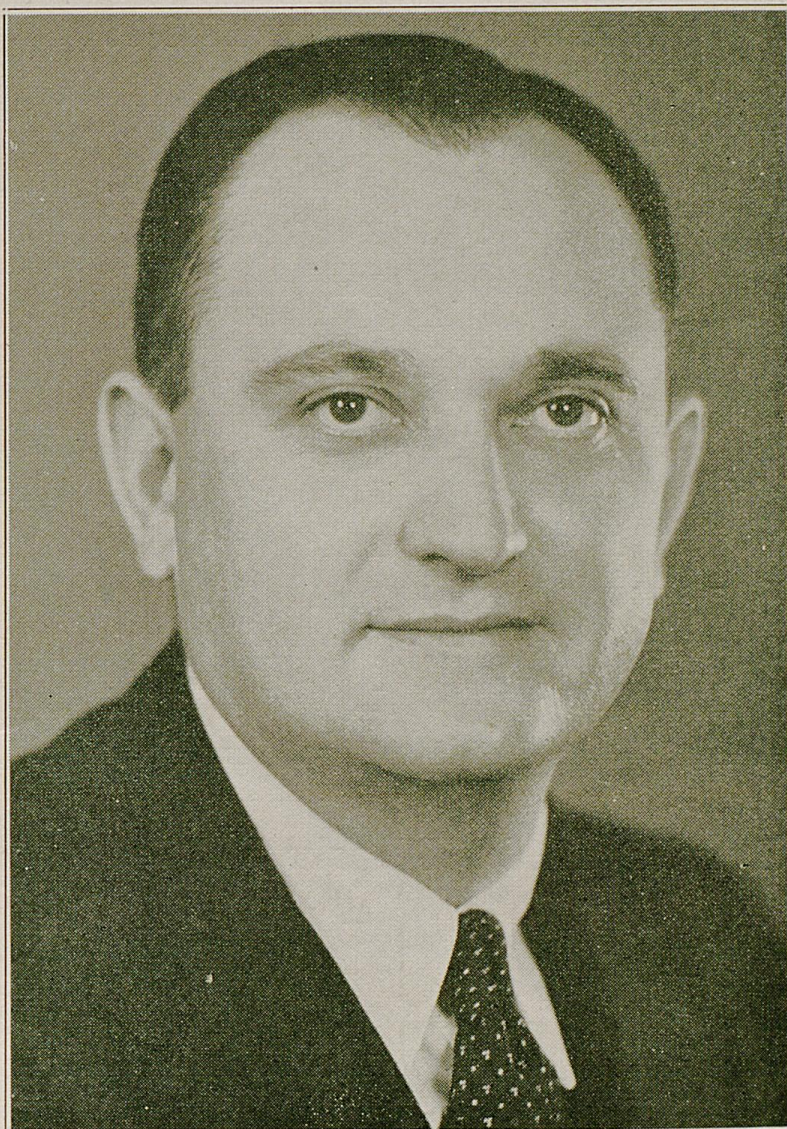

A native of Kansas, where he was a basketball star at the University of Kansas, Adolph Rupp is now in the midst of his ninth season as head coach of the University of Kentucky Wildcats. During his tenure at Kentucky, Coach Rupp has made a remarkable record, winning undisputed championships of the Southeastern Conference three times and having a good claim to the title in four other years. He has developed three All-Americans and a host of all-conference players for Kentucky.

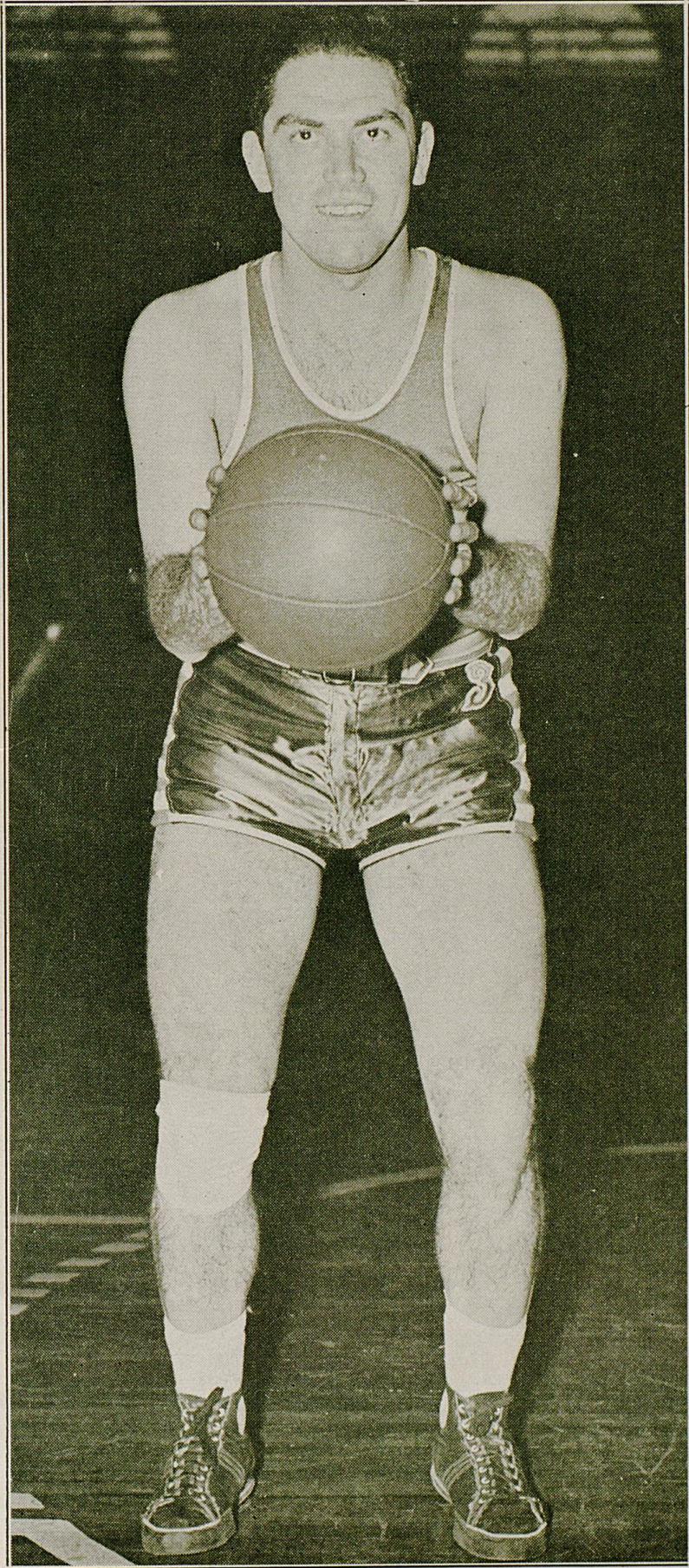

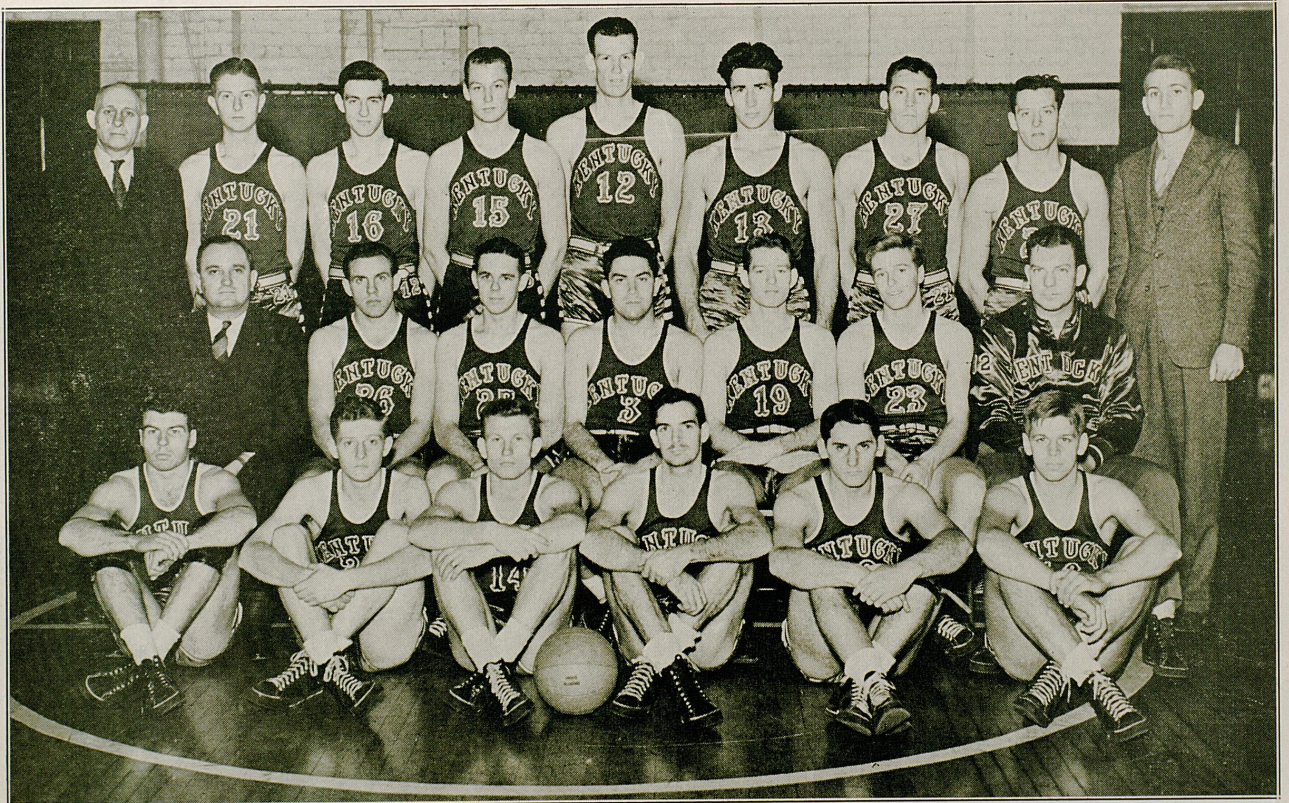

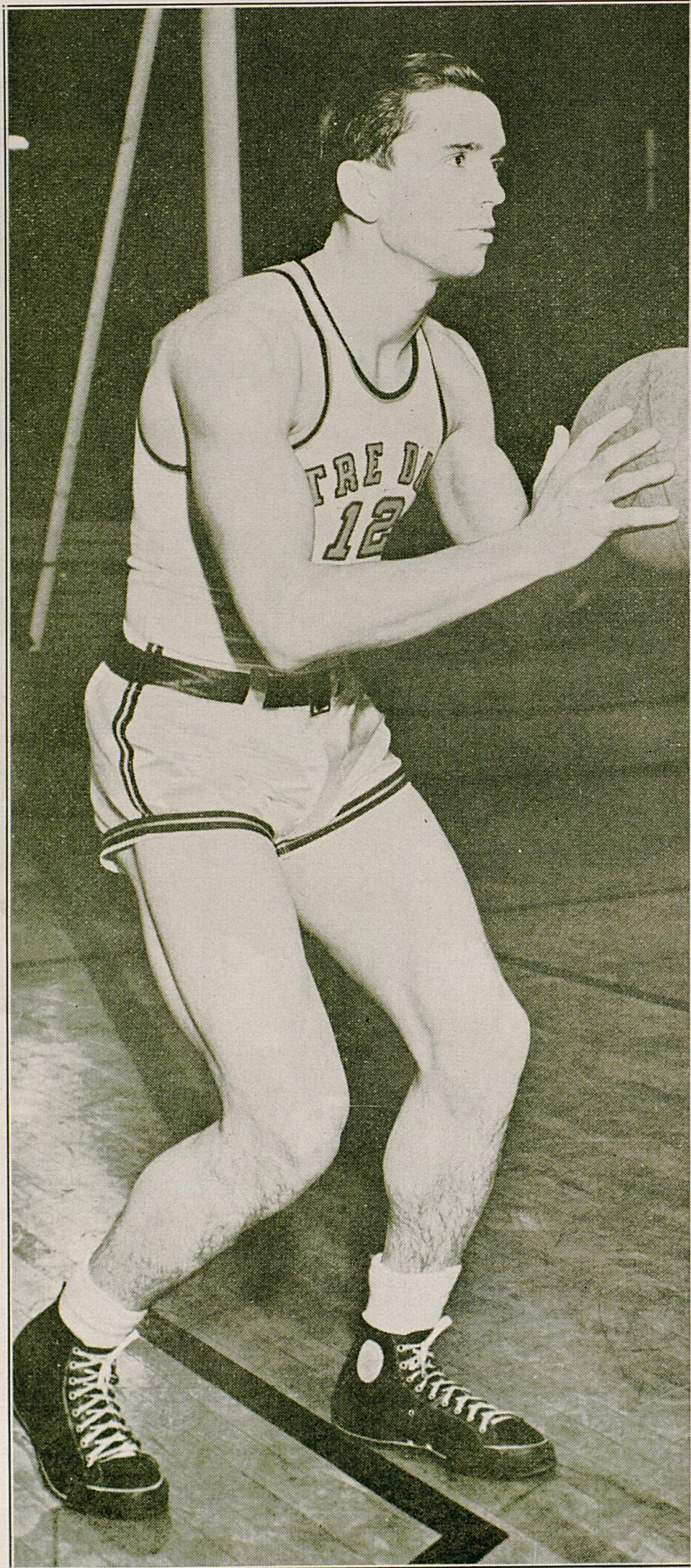
