## DID YOU KNOW?

Burgess Carey, 6' 0" guard, was voted UK's second All-American in 1925. He was a powerfully-built backguard, a defensive specialist who seldom went beyond midcourt and did not shoot the ball. He was stationed permanently under the basket, where he would plant his big (6' 0", 195 lbs.) body and dare anybody to invade his territory. He was captain of his UK squad. He later ran a construction company in Lexington that still bears his name.
