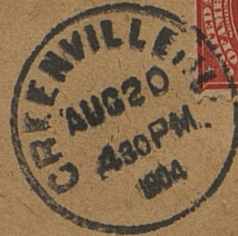

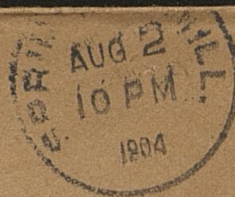

ride through the Alps. Geneva
is a fine place, too. You had

We are steaming along the
Riviera now, which means the
Mediterranean coast of Southern
France and Northern Italy, and
just passed Monte Carlo.

I looked over and saw the casino
where in time past I had dropped
a good many five franc pieces
playing "the wheel", as roulette
is called. There is nothing in
it, gambling is a bad thing
enough, but at Monte Carlo
one feels that he ought to.

I have not had any tennis
since I left Tangier, although
I had a chance to play in

I just looked out
the port, we are pass-
ing Villefranche,
