Minutes of the University Senate - January 13, 1941

The following recommendation from the University Council was presented to the Senate:

"The Council recommends to the Senate that the President be urged to appoint a Senate committee, to be known as a University Defense Council to determine the activities in which the University may properly be engaged in connection with national defense."

The Senate approved this recommendation with an amendment providing that the Committee be composed of seven members, to be appointed by the President of the University.

President Cooper announced to the Senate that the Commencement Exercises would be held on February 3, at 3 o'clock, with President Raymond A. Kent, of the University of Louisville as the speaker. He also announced the Baccalaureate Services, scheduled for four o'clock on Sunday, February 2, with Dr. Jesse Herrmann, Pastor of the Second Presbyterian Church, as the speaker.
