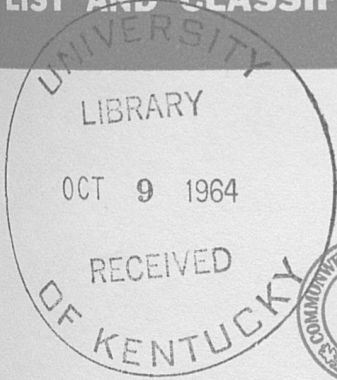

## FOREWORD

In issuing this bulletin, listing all elementary schools of the state for the school-year 1963-64, I have reviewed with much interest the great improvement taking place in the area of elementary education. The progress is remarkable and I want to commend highly all of those who have worked to bring about this progress.

Elementary schools of eight or more teachers are classified in relation to a **Standard School**. Appropriate standards and criteria are written into the regulations for accrediting elementary schools adopted by the State Board of Education. It is significant to note the number of schools achieving the standard rating compared with the number last year and the gradual increase in this number for the five-year period since 1959. Yet with this progress much remains to be done. Therefore, I want to impress on all personnel engaged with the improvement of elementary education to proceed forward toward, not only meeting the minimum requirements for a standard school, but to go far beyond to a high quality diversified program for the children of the state.

I trust this bulletin will be helpful.

## ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS FOR THE SCHOOL-YEAR 1963-64

There were 974 elementary schools accredited by the State Board of Education during the school year 1963-64. Of this number 616 were under the control of the county school districts and 236 were under the control of the independent districts. Sixteen were State, Federal, or Regional schools and 106 were private schools. As will be seen, there was a variety of organizations according to the grades included in the type of organization. By far, the greatest number of organizations conform to a 1-8 type of organization or a 1-6 organization. Of these 569 were organizations offering a program from one through the eighth grade and 269 offered a program from one to six grades making a total of 865 schools out of 974.

Table I below shows the number of accredited elementary schools classified according to the type of control for five years from 1959-64.

The total number of elementary schools operating in Kentucky, including all of the elementary schools of seven teachers and below as well as the 947 accredited schools, numbered 2,236 schools. Of this number, there were 694 one-teacher schools compared to 851 one-teacher schools last year. Comparison of the schools of other sizes can be seen by study of the summary information included in the back of this book.

The number of pupils enrolled in the accredited elementary schools continues to grow. This year there were 426,813 pupils enrolled in these schools for the year. Of this number 262,980 were in the schools under the control of the county school districts, and

102,877 were enrolled in the schools under the control of the independent school districts. The others were enrolled in schools which were operated by State, Regional, or Federal authorities or in the private schools.

In all of the elementary schools there was a total staff of 18,709 teachers, supervisors, principals, and other special instructional personnel serving during the school year of 1963-64. Of this number 15,381 or approximately 82 per cent were serving in the schools of eight or more teachers or schools accredited by the State Board of Education. There is indication that the professional staff is growing not only in quantity but in quality as well. During the school year of 1963-64 nearly 84 per cent of the total staff had a quality of training of a Bachelor's Degree plus, 153 semester hours. This was an increase of 5.2 per cent over the previous year and over 27 per cent in five years from 1959-60 to 1963-64.

Table IV below gives the median prepared of all elementary school personnel for a sixteen year period from 1948-64.

The trend in the development of the elementary schools throughout the state is towards the larger elementary school unit in order to make it practical to offer an effective program of education.

Table V following shows the number of elementary schools accredited for the school year of 1963-64 compared with the school year of 1959-60, classified according to size.

It will be seen from a study of Table V that the schools of 16 teachers and below, have decreased in number from 616 to 603 during the five-year period while the schools of 17 teachers and above have increased from 248 to 371.
