The faculty met in special session on Tuesday afternoon, May the eighth, nineteen hundred and seventeen, President Barker presiding. Quorum present.

President Barker stated that at the request of the deans, the faculty had been called together and asked Professor Miller to state the purpose of the meeting.

Professor Miller stated that the faculty was called for the purpose of considering the advisability of placing a time limit on the practice of allowing students to substitute work on the farm for class room work. After a general discussion by the faculty, Professor Miller offered the following resolution which was adopted:

That the order of the faculty permitting students to return home to work on the farm and count their work in lieu of class room duties be rescinded as relates to students now in college for the remainder of the session.
