I went and see my commander and he said for me to have three ~~people~~ people ^{to write to me} for them

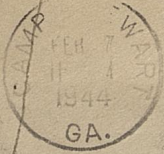
to say how you are becose I said that my dad was sick and they wount to have some probe but it can not be none of my cousin it has to be some one

Do you want the Picture back I can sent them back to you if you want to?

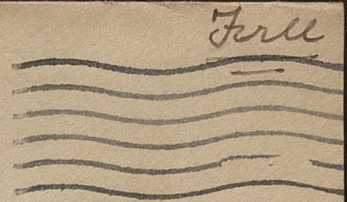
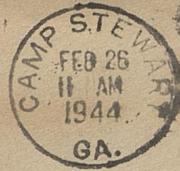
How did uncle Edward like it in Ohio? I gess that

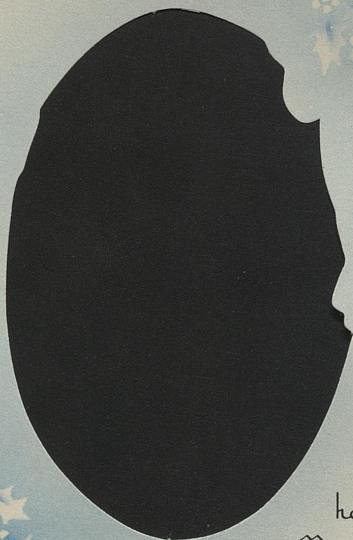
