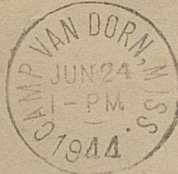

Dear, mother, Father and Brother.

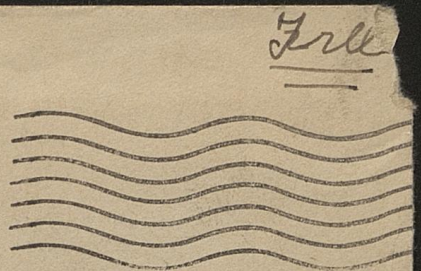

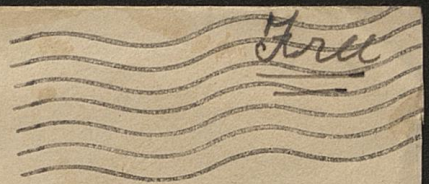
