

C O N T R A C T .

[7 July 1902]

This agreement entered into July 17, 1902, between W. B. Matthews, Chairman of the Local Committee of the Negro Young People's Christian and Educational Congress, of Atlanta, party of the first part, and W. W. Lucas, party of the second part, witnesseth that party of the first part will hold and control concessions at Piedmont Park, Atlanta, Ga, beginning August 6-11, 1902.

And for the money consideration hereinafter named, party of the first part does hereby grant and convey to the party of the second part all rights and privileges to sell water melons at said Park during the time herein aforesaid mentioned, Sunday excepted.

The party of the first part herein also grants and concedes all rights and privileges to sell ice cream, soda water and soft drinks to the said party of the second part.

In consideration of the foregoing and in payment for the rights granted by the party of the first part, the party of the second part agrees to pay the party of the first part the sum of \$110.00. Of this amount \$55.00 shall be paid upon the signing and delivery of this agreement and \$55.00 shall be paid on or before August 6th, 1902.

The party of the first part agrees to assign to the party of the second part the following space, the same to be used only for the purposes named in this agreement, and the party of the second part shall have no right to dispose of this space or to re-assign same without the written consent of the party of the first part:-

*Space on right entering the front door of auditorium. On rear of building space approved by*

*Local Committee.*

- (1) The party of the second part agrees that <sup>good</sup> order shall be kept at and around stands consigned to him during the exercises in the Hall.
- (2) The party of the second part agrees to keep grounds around stands clean, free from filth, trash and refuse matter of any kind resulting from sales or other transactions about said stands.
- (3) The party of the second part agrees to sell nothing except things mentioned in this contract.
- (4) The party of the second part will not be allowed to sell inside the building where the exercises are held while these exercises are in session.

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The party of the first part hereby grants and concedes all rights and privileges to sell ice cream, soda water and soft drinks to the said party of the second part.

In consideration of the foregoing and in payment for the rights granted by the party of the first part, the party of the second part agrees to pay the party of the first part the sum of \$110.00. Of this amount \$50.00 shall be paid upon the signing and delivery of this agreement and \$60.00 shall be paid on or before August 8th, 1902.

The party of the first part agrees to assign to the party of the second part the following booth, the same to be used only for the purposes named in this agreement, and the party of the second part shall have no right to dispose of this space or to re-assign same without the written consent of the party of the first part:

- (1) The party of the second part agrees that order shall be kept at and around stands assigned to him during the exercises in the Hall.
- (2) The party of the second part agrees to keep grounds around stands clean free from litter, trash and refuse water of any kind resulting from sales or other transactions about said stands.
- (3) The party of the second part agrees to sell nothing except things mentioned in this contract.
- (4) The party of the second part will not be allowed to sell inside the building where the exercises are held while these exercises are in session.

C O N T R A C T -- (continued)

No criers shall be allowed on the ground.

The Fair Grounds being within the corporate limits of the city of Atlanta, it is understood and agreed by the party of the second part that the conduct of business on the Fair Grounds must conform to the law and order regulations of the Police Department of the city of Atlanta.

It is further understood and agreed by the party of the second part that all booths, decorations, signs, etc., must meet with the approval of the Local Committee.

It is further understood and agreed by the party of the second part that the failure to fulfill the conditions of this contract, renders same null and void, and thereby forfeits all payments or deposits already made.
