The faculty met in regular monthly session in the President's room at 8:30 am. All present except Messrs. Patterson, and Pryor.

The minutes of the last two meetings were read, corrected and approved.

*Officers of the Day Detail for* The commandant called attention to the fact that he had found some difficulty in detailing cadets to act as "Officer of the Day" for the reason that they are graded zero when absent from recitations.

The sense of the faculty was that the class-standing of a cadet detailed for special duty should not be reduced, provided, that in each case the cadet be required to present a written statement, signed by the Commandant and President <sup>giving</sup> explaining why he was absent.

*Demerits to be reported* Attention was called to fact that it is the duty of each Professor and of each assistant to report promptly, to the President, at the end of each month, all demerits assessed during that month.

*Committee to determine Class honors* Prof. Shackelford moved that a committee be appointed to determine the class honors for this year, and also to determine what members of the class shall take part in the Commencement exercises.

The Chair appointed the Deans of the several Courses of study.
