

April 20th The Faculty met at the usual hour.
 Honorable discharges were granted to Messrs. J. R. Button
 and J. Dean. C. E. Talbot was reported for general
 neglect of duty. The President was requested to privately
 reprimand him. J. C. Laughlin (at his Mother's request)
 was reprimanded by the President for his neglect of duty.
 Messrs Fisher and Carswell appeared before the Faculty
 as representatives of contending parties in the distribution
 of funds from the sale of club (now broken up) property.
 The printed regulations for the government of Clubs not
 specifying what shall be done in such a case the Faculty
 recommended that all who are now in the University shall
 have a meeting and appoint a Committee to make a
 distribution on friendly and just terms.
 G. H. Bryan was excused from drill at his father's
 request. Mr. Cortch was reported for neglect of duty and
 the Pres. was asked to give him a "talk" on the subject.
 On motion the Faculty adjourned.

May 5th The Faculty met as usual.
 Mr. J. S. Mc. Thee having been absent, and having failed
 to comply with the regulation passed by the Faculty at their
 meeting Dec 9th, was again before the Faculty. When
 questioned about his conduct, he made use of improper
 language in regard to one of the members of the Faculty.
 His general conduct was reduced to 10% and he was (in
 Mrs. Bowman's absence) required to bring a note, signed by
 Mr. A. H. Bowman and countersigned by Maj. White, stating
 that he was unable to attend to his duties while absent from
 school. Messrs Burchell and Gibson were excused from
 Algebra. David Barrow was reported for using impudent
 language toward one Mr. Smith in class room. It was
 resolved that he be privately reprimanded by the Pres.
 and that he shall apologize to Mr. Smith. A furlough
 till the beginning of next session was granted to J. L. Metcalf
 at his father's request. H. F. L. Thompson having been
 absent from his duties for some weeks past, and having
 disregarded twice a summons to meet the Faculty and account
 for his absence was publicly dismissed. The Faculty then adjourned.
