Object of the meeting, appropriate action relative to the death of Hon. R. A. Spurr.

On motion of Professor Shackelford ordered that a committee of five be appointed to prepare suitable resolutions of respect touching the death of Captain Spurr, and that the President be chairman of that committee.

The sense of the faculty was that all its members should attend the funeral interment if in the Lexington Cemetery, that the Committee on resolutions should represent the faculty if the interment should be in the Country.

The President called the attention of the faculty to the fact that Prof. Wells has severed his connection with the College and suggested that the faculty take some action expressive of its esteem and regard for him.
