KENTUCKY RIVER BRIDGE--CINCINNATI SOUTHERN RAILWAY.

VIEW No. 4.—Span No. 1, (375 feet in length) just before reaching Pier No. 1, taken from old orchard in the bottom, above the Bridge, November 14th, 1876. Built without scaffolding 187½ feet out from the end of the Bridge, to the temporary wooden pier, by anchorage at the end of the Bridge. Total length of Bridge 1125 feet—3 spans of 375 feet each. Height of rail above foundation of piers, 286 feet. Designed and built by *Baltimore Bridge Company*, C. SHALER SMITH, Engineer, under direction of THOS. D. LOVETT, Chief Engineer, C. S. Railway.
