Prof. Rowe moved that Mr. Carey's name be omitted from the list and considered later. This was made unnecessary by the withdrawal of Mr. Carey's name from the list by Prof. Anderson. Mr. Carey's name was omitted and the remaining candidates were recommended for graduation.

Prof. Anderson then moved that George B. Carey be recommended to the Board of Trustees for the degree of Bachelor of Mechanical Engineering.

The motion was seconded.

Prof. Rowe stated that on May 1st, when Mr. Carey's name was presented and accepted as a candidate for the degree of Bachelor of Mechanical Engineering, the faculty was under the impression that he had almost completed his college course. He further stated that he had examined the records and found that

Mr. Carey had no credit for college English and that his only credit in Mathematics was for Plane Geometry and Algebra.

Prof. Anderson stated that at that time the records were not as complete as at present and it was possible that some things had been omitted. He referred to Mr. Carey as an excellent student and said that he had succeeded in life, and that he was willing to take the responsibility of recommending him for a degree.

Judge Chalkley arose to a point of order and when asked to state the point, declared that the constitution of Kentucky forbade the State University to grant the A.B. degree or its equivalent except for work done in the University.

The point was ruled out of order.

In the general discussion that followed Lieut. Gullion moved that Mr. Carey be recommended to the Board of Trustees for the honorary degree of Mechanical Engineering.

Judge Chalkley called attention to the fact that the motion was out of order and stated that this recommendation should come from the Graduate School Committee. Judge Chalkley was sustained by President Barker.

Mr. Carey's name was submitted to the faculty for the degree of B.M.E. and a standing vote was called for.

The motion was lost by one vote.
