My Dear Brother

As I wrote to you from Cincinnati and to Pa from Whiting I think that you are entitled to the next letter we arrived at Port Morgan, a week ago yesterday they were not expecting us but were very much delighted to see us and I have spent my time very agreeably Mr Morgan has gone to Mansfield but will be back this evening and then he will go on to New York. I expect to go to Mansfield in about ten days to stay until I go back to Kentucky which I hope will be the first of September I have heard that Mr & Mrs Culp have come on to spend the summer in Richmond and I expect they will be going back to Texas the first of September I intend to write to her to day to let me know when she will go and if they return sooner than Mrs Baker I will come on with them and remain in Kentucky until Mr Morgan returns from New York he looks much better and has a good appetite and they all tell me that I have greatly improved and I think myself that I look better and I am sure I never had a
