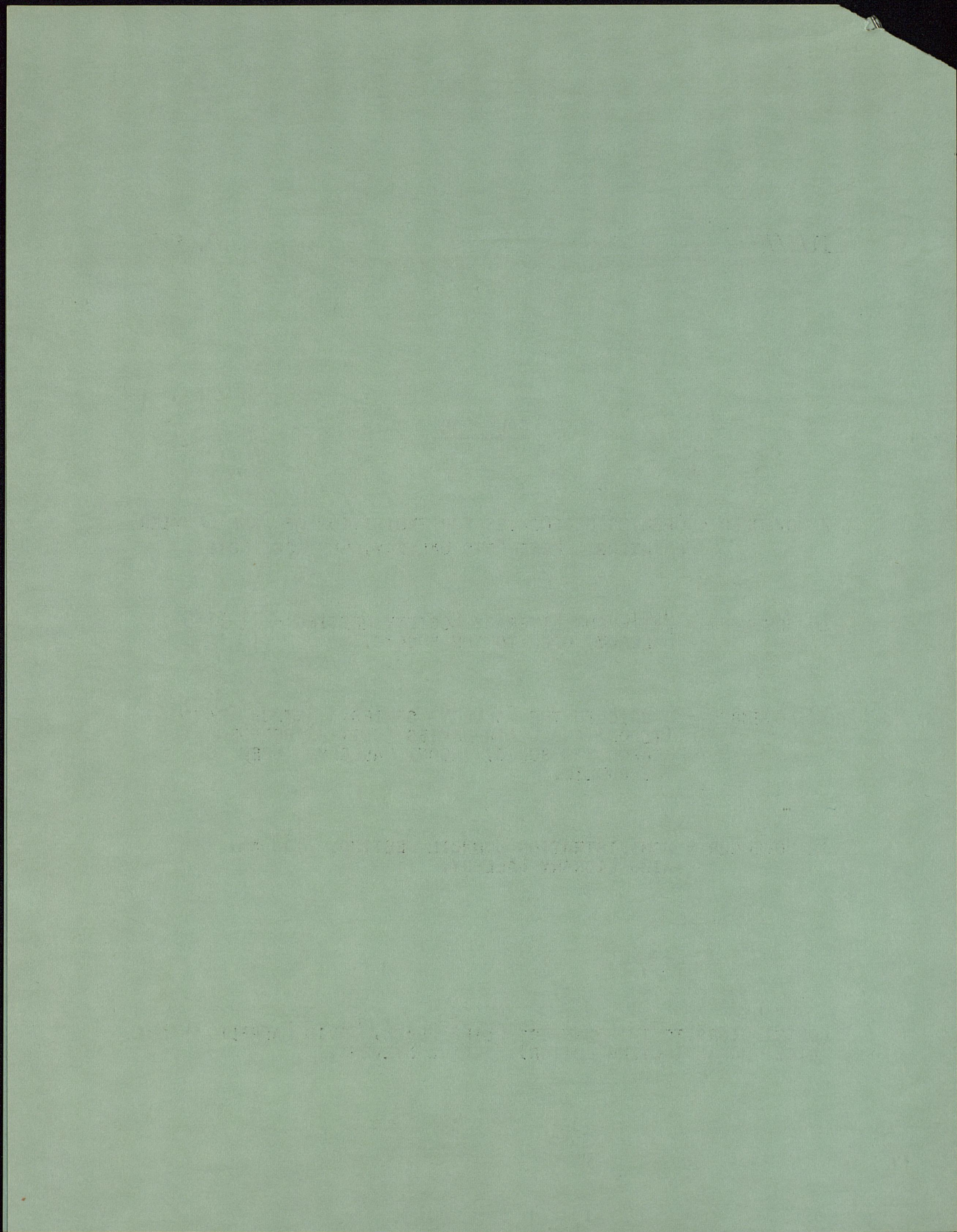

### REPORT ON THE HERMANN ZAPF SEMINAR:

THE KING LIBRARY PRESS HOSTED A SUCCESSFUL SEMINAR IN GRAPHIC DESIGN ON 21-22 OCTOBER. THE SEMINAR FEATURED HERMANN ZAPF, A DISTINGUISHED ALPHABET AND BOOK DESIGNER FROM WEST GERMANY, AND DREW SEVERAL HUNDRED PARTICIPANTS FROM ACROSS KENTUCKY AND BORDERING STATES. THE LECTURES AND WORKSHOPS WERE RECORDED ON AUDIO AND VIDEO TAPE AND A DOZEN PIECES OF GRAPHIC ART WERE DRAWN BY MR. ZAPF, ALL FOR SPECIAL COLLECTIONS' TYPOGRAPHY ARCHIVE.

## NINI REVIEWS

A NEW SPEC KIT, "SYSTEMS FUNCTION" HAS RECENTLY BEEN PUBLISHED. IT DEALS WITH THE RESULTS OF A JANUARY 1976 SPEC SURVEY REQUESTED AND SUPPORTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, LOS ANGELES LIBRARY, ON THE SYSTEMS FUNCTION IN ARL LIBRARIES. THE SURVEY MADE INQUIRES CONCERNING THE

ORIENTATION OF THE SYSTEMS EFFORT (AUTOMATED OR MANUAL AND MANAGERIAL SYSTEMS), THE LIBRARY UNITS AND PERSONNEL INVOLVED IN THE SYSTEMS FUNCTION AND THE TYPES OF ACTIVITIES INCLUDED WITHIN THE FUNCTION. THE SURVEY ALSO REQUESTED INFORMATION CONCERNING FUTURE TRENDS AND DIRECTIONS PROJECTED FOR THE SYSTEMS FUNCTION IN THE INDIVIDUAL LIBRARIES AND DESCRIPTION OF SYSTEMS PROJECTS CURRENTLY BEING CONDUCTED. THE KIT WILL BE FILED WITH THE OTHER KITS IN THE VERTICAL FILE OF THE REFERENCE DEPARTMENT IN KING LIBRARY.
