Louisville, Jan 1. - 1908 - Reports from the Western Kentucky mining districts say the strike called by the Executive Committee began today and a number of miners have gone out, though it is impossible to say how many. Webster county seems to have been affected most. The miners' officers claim the mines there are tied up and that six hundred men are out. The operators say the mines in Hopkins county are not affected and are running as usual. There has been no trouble.
