3 Roads Here Hit By Strike,
About 150 Out.

C & O., L & N. And Southern
Railway affected - Twelve extra
men sworn in to help guard
property of one line - no disorder
expected.

It was estimated at noon today
that about 150 men on the C & O,
L & N. And Southern railways
here had responded to the
general strike order.

There was no disorder.

Definite figures were not
obtainable, but it was understood
that about 150 men had quit
work.
