Faculty met in special session in the faculty room Wednesday, January 12", at 3:45 P.M. Quorum present. In the absence of President Barker, Judge Lafferty presided.

Professor Miller made the following motion:

All subjects dropped to avoid failure should be, at the discretion of the dean, counted as a failure and entered as such on the records in the Registrar's office. Motion was seconded by Professor Noe. Motion adopted.

The following recommendations from the Committee of Deans were adopted:

- 1. "When an ~~undergraduate~~ undergraduate student is trans-^{cond}ferred from one college to another, any condition which he may happen to have incurred is not to be regarded as a disability unless the condition is vital to the new course".)
- 2. "That all undergraduates who participate in athletics should, during the athletic season, be excused from military drill or gymnasium work of any kind, and that a record be kept of each student's athletic activities. If a student be found delinquent in practice work, the said student shall be required to substitute work in the gymnasium."
- 3. "That any condition obtained by a student^{cond} in any collegiate year, which is not removed before the beginning of the next collegiate year, becomes a failure and must be taken over again in class if he is to receive credit for same."
- 4. "That all engineering students be excused from Gymnasium work."

The Secretary requested that a committee be appointed to investigate the practice in other institutions of granting degrees to Special Students who have not received credit for high school work, and to recommend a policy to govern similar cases in the University of Kentucky. On motion of Dr. Pryor, this was referred to the Committee of Deans.

At the request of Dr. Tuthill a committee composed of Professors Noe, Weaver, and Dr. Tuthill was appointed to represent the interests of the University at the Kentucky Educational Association.

On motion the faculty adjourned. *E. F. Gillis*
