LIBRARY TECHNICIANS

The University Personnel Division recently suggested that the new Library Technician classification series should constitute a promotion ladder for those within the group and special provisions were decided upon for movement from the Library Technician I category to Library Technician II. I would like to explain the procedures to be followed:

Persons entering the Library system at the Library Technician I level will, over a period of time, become more proficient in their assigned duties. The specialized knowledge and training they receive will, in most cases, make them eligible for promotion to the Library Technician II grade. All Library Technician grade I's will be automatically reviewed for promotion to Library Technician Grade II after two successful years as a LT-I. The annual performance evaluation reviews will be used in this process.

Please note that this applies only for grade LT-I to LT-II and not for the other grades. Also, a promotion to a LT-II will not necessarily involve a salary adjustment since an individual in a LT-I position for two years will usually have a salary above the normal starting rate for a LT-II.

This does allow us to promote someone for doing a job well without necessitating a change of positions or reclassification. I am pleased that Personnel recommended this to us and that we are able to implement it.
