KENTUCKY MINING LAW

SECTION 13: OPERATOR'S ANNUAL REPORT TO THE DEPARTMENT OF MINES AND MINERALS

THE OWNER, LESSEE, OR SUPERINTENDENT OF EACH MINE TO WHICH THIS LAW APPLIES SHALL ALSO BE REQUIRED TO GIVE AT THE END OF EACH CALENDAR YEAR ENDING DECEMBER THIRTY-FIRST ACCURATE INFORMATION ON BLANKS TO BE FURNISHED BY THE CHIEF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MINES AND MINERALS, AS TO THE NUMBER OF ACCIDENTS THAT HAVE OCCURRED, THE NUMBER OF PERSONS EMPLOYED, THE TONS OF COAL MINED AT SUCH MINE, AND SUCH OTHER INFORMATION NOT OF A PRIVATE NATURE AS THE CHIEF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MINES AND MINERALS MAY REQUEST.

SECTION 55: PENALTIES

ANY COAL OPERATOR WHO SHALL VIOLATE ANY OF THE PROVISIONS CONTAINED IN SECTION 13 OF THIS ACT, SHALL UPON CONVICTION THEREOF, BE FINED NOT LESS THAN TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) NOR MORE THAN TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00).
