Many thanks, Mr. Hurley, for the courtesy shown our Mr. Smith, when he called on you today. We appreciate this very much. We have played in this vicinity for 15 years and have always tried hard to "keep friends" with all of our schools.

In fact, we have many schools who use us year after year. Mr. Halley, Supt. Zanesfield school recently used us for the third time. Recently we played Cable (Ohio) school for the fourth time. And so on.

We would be very glad to appear at North Lewisburg and under the auspices of your school, and assure you a very clean, interesting and worth-while program in every respect.

Most attractions, of like merit, ask 65 to 75% of the proceeds. They furnish you with a few window cards and the ~~RESS~~ is up to the school. Quite often they ask a guarantee of the first 25.00 taken in.

Here is our liberal offer to your school. We will furnish you with "coming" posters, window cards, plenty of tickets to sell in advance, also small handbills. On the night selected furnish you with one of the finest programs you have ever sponsored.

In return for our services we ask 60% of the proceeds. We ask NO guarantee, all we ask is your co-operation in the ticket sale. Your percentage is CLEAR as you need not invest one penny.

When wanted (and this feature is preferred by many schools) we can furnish a one hour student matinee at 10¢. Most of our evening dates are now played at 15¢ for children and 25¢ for adults. However in the last few months some communities feel that they can do best at 10 and 20¢, so we leave that to your committee. Set the prices that you think will bring the best results.

Mr. Smith informs me that there is a possibility that you could use us on Friday, March 17th. We now have that date open and hope you can use us at that time. If so we would be glad to have an early confirmation. Be sure and give us all necessary information to assist in getting out the publicity material.
