Faculty met in called meeting at 12 M. in the President's room. Present were: Pres^r Patterson, Prof^r Kirby, Peter, Shackford, White, Neville, Meux, Helveti, R. B. Paterson, Cadet E. D. Scott, Peace and Col. Phelps. Object of meeting, as stated by the President, charges against Cadet E. D. Scott, brought before the Faculty from the Board of Discipline. The charges are: Cutting a fellow student with intent to wound, without provocation. After the charges had been amended so as to read, without sufficient provocation. Cadets Agee, Hampton, Stanley, Long, Offutt, Duan and the wounded Cadet Maxwell were heard as witnesses in the case, Cadet Scott and his father being present. Cadet Scott and his father then having withdrawn the accused was found guilty as charged, by a ^{unanimous} vote of 4, and it was moved and seconded that he, Cadet E. D. Scott be dismissed from College. Reading his motion, Faculty adjourned for further consideration of the case until Jan. 14th 1. P. M. at the same place.
