PREFACE

THE HISTORICAL RECORDS SURVEY WAS ESTABLISHED IN WEST VIRGINIA IN 1936 AS PART OF THE FEDERAL HISTORICAL RECORDS SURVEY, UNDER THE NATIONAL DIRECTION OF DR. LUTHER H. EVANS. PURSUANT TO AN ACT OF CONGRESS, THE FEDERAL HISTORICAL RECORDS SURVEY, WITH OTHER WORK PROJECTS ADMINISTRATION FEDERAL PROJECTS, WAS TERMINATED AUGUST 31, 1939. ITS WORK IN WEST VIRGINIA HAS BEEN CONTINUED SINCE THAT TIME BY THE WEST VIRGINIA HISTORICAL RECORDS SURVEY, SPONSORED BY THE WEST VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION UNTIL JULY 1, 1940 AND AFTER THAT DATE BY THE WEST VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF ARCHIVES AND HISTORY. MR. SARGENT B. CHILD SUCCEEDED DR. EVANS AS DIRECTOR OF HISTORICAL RECORDS SURVEY PROJECTS MARCH 1, 1940.

THE BIBLIOGRAPHY OF MATERIAL RELATING TO CHURCHES IN THIS AND OTHER STATES IS PRESENTED IN PRELIMINARY FORM WITH THE REALIZATION THAT THE LISTING IS FAR FROM COMPLETE AND THAT, AS WORK PROGRESSES ON THE INVENTORY OF CHURCH ARCHIVES NEW MATERIAL WILL CONSTANTLY BE ADDED. THIS BIBLIOGRAPHY WAS PREPARED FOR USE BY THE EDITORIAL FORCE OF THE WEST VIRGINIA HISTORICAL RECORDS SURVEY WITH NO THOUGHT OF PUBLICATION. HOWEVER, THE WASHINGTON OFFICE SAW FIT TO ASK THAT THE BIBLIOGRAPHY BE PUBLISHED IN PRELIMINARY FORM.

BECAUSE MANY WEST VIRGINIA CHURCHES HAVE THEIR ROOTS IN VIRGINIA CHURCHES THIS BIBLIOGRAPHY INCLUDES SOME MATERIAL FOR THAT STATE, AND BECAUSE WE MUST FREQUENTLY CONSULT THE RECORDS OF KENTUCKY AND SOUTHERN OHIO CHURCHES IN COMPILING OUR HISTORY THESE TOO HAVE BEEN INCLUDED. CHURCHES FOLLOWED SETTLEMENTS, AND MANY VIRGINIA CHURCHES ARE MOTHER CHURCHES OF THOSE IN WEST VIRGINIA WHILE OUR CHURCHES SERVED AS MOTHER CHURCHES TO THOSE FARTHER WEST.

THE MAJOR PORTION OF THE WORK ON THIS VOLUME WAS DONE BY IRVIN E. YOUNG, ASSISTANT STATE SUPERVISOR OF THE PROJECT, AND NOW OF WASHINGTON, D. C. ADDITIONAL WORK IN PREPARATION FOR PUBLICATION HAS BEEN DONE BY WILLIAM FRED CONNER, CHURCH EDITOR, AND REX S. WOLFE, PRESENT ASSISTANT STATE SUPERVISOR.

INTRODUCTION

THE LIST OF TITLES PRESENTED HERE REPRESENTS PUBLICATIONS RELATING TO CHURCHES IN THIS AND ADJOINING STATES. WHILE THIS IS NOT AN EXHAUSTIVE LIST IT IS A LIST OF PUBLICATIONS WHICH ARE AVAILABLE TO WEST VIRGINIA WORKERS EITHER AT THE DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY AND ARCHIVES LIBRARY IN CHARLESTON OR AT THE STATE UNIVERSITY LIBRARY IN MORGANTOWN.

BECAUSE THE TRACING OF CHURCH HISTORY IS OFTEN LIKE THE TRACING OF FAMILY TREES, THE MATERIAL FOR ADJOINING STATES MUST BE CONSULTED IN ORDER TO UNDERSTAND THE EMIGRATION OF CERTAIN SECTS. THAT ENTIRE CHURCHES CAN BE MOVED FROM ONE STATE TO ANOTHER IS EVIDENCED BY THE SEVENTH DAY BAPTIST CHURCH AT SALEM, WHEN AN ENTIRE CHURCH BODY MOVED AND BROUGHT THEIR RECORDS FROM THEIR ORIGINAL NEW JERSEY SETTLEMENT, CARRYING ON THEIR ORGANIZATION IN THEIR NEW HOME WITHOUT A BREAK. VIRGINIA CHURCH HISTORY MUST BE CONSULTED FOR OUR STATE EXISTED FOR A LONGER PERIOD AS A PART OF VIRGINIA THAN SHE HAS EXISTED AS THE STATE OF WEST VIRGINIA. KENTUCKY AND OHIO MUST ALSO BE CONSIDERED FOR THE SAME MEN WHO ORGANIZED THE PIONEER CHURCHES IN THIS STATE PLAYED A LARGE PART IN THE ORGANIZATION OF KENTUCKY AND OHIO CHURCHES.

IN TRACING CHURCH HISTORY THE FILES OF THE PUBLICATIONS OF THE WILLIAM AND MARY QUARTERLY, THE VIRGINIA MAGAZINE OF HISTORY AND BIOGRAPHY AND THE ACTS OF THE EARLY ASSEMBLIES AS REPORTED BY HENING ARE VALUABLE SOURCES FOR MATERIAL. THESE HAVE NOT BEEN INCLUDED IN THIS LIST BUT ARE AVAILABLE AT THE STATE LIBRARY AND ARE THOROUGHLY INDEXED BY SWEMS INDEX TO VIRGINIA HISTORY.

ANOTHER VALUABLE SOURCE FOR CHURCH HISTORY IS THE VARIOUS COUNTY HISTORIES WHICH ARE NOT INCLUDED IN THIS LIST. PRACTICALLY EVERY COUNTY HISTORY HAS AT LEAST ONE CHAPTER DEVOTED TO INDIVIDUAL CHURCHES, AND WHILE THIS MATERIAL IS NOT ALWAYS ACCURATE, IT FORMS AN EXCELLENT CHECK LIST AND HELPS IN LOCATING DEFUNCT CHURCHES. A SERIES OF BULLETINS, WRITTEN BY THE FARM CLUB MEMBERS, AND PUBLISHED BY THE AGRICULTURAL DEPARTMENT OF WEST VIRGINIA UNIVERSITY, IS ALSO A SOURCE FOR INFORMATION OF RURAL CHURCHES. THESE BULLETINS EACH COVER A RURAL COMMUNITY AND ARE FILED AT THE STATE LIBRARY.

THERE ARE TWO COLLECTIONS AT THE STATE LIBRARY, ONE FOR THE BAPTIST CHURCH AND ONE FOR THE METHODIST CHURCH. THESE COLLECTIONS ARE STORED IN STEEL CABINETS AND ARE NOT AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC, BEING THE PROPERTY OF THE DENOMINATION TO WHICH THEY BELONG. NO SHELF CARDS HAVE BEEN PREPARED FOR THE MATERIAL WHICH CONSISTS OF CONFERENCE AND ASSOCIATION MINUTES, BOOKS, PUBLICATION FILES, AND A FEW MINUTE BOOKS. HOWEVER, PERMISSION TO USE THIS MATERIAL CAN USUALLY BE OBTAINED FROM THE PERSON IN CHARGE OF THE COLLECTION.

THIS LIST HAS BEEN BROKEN DOWN UNDER DENOMINATIONAL HEADINGS, TO EACH OF WHICH HAS BEEN GIVEN A ROMAN NUMERAL. THESE HEADINGS ARE GENERAL. THUS THE HEADING "THE METHODISTS" INCLUDE MATERIAL ON THE METHODIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH, THE PROTESTANT METHODIST CHURCH, AND THE METHODIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH, SOUTH. THE BAPTIST HEADING COVERS THE MISSIONARY, PRIMITIVE, AND SEVENTH DAY BAPTIST CHURCHES.
