**SEED INSPECTION IN KENTUCKY, 1944-45**

Abnormal weather during the summer and fall of 1944 brought about new problems for producers of seed. The premature ripening of such seeds as corn and tobacco caused by the unusually dry summer, was suddenly checked by a rainy season beginning August 15 and lasting until October. The irregular ripening and the new growth caused by the rains, together with the high moisture content of the seed at the time of harvest, may have caused the lowered vitality which was indicated by extreme variations in germination tests.

Irregularities in the preliminary cleaning of tobacco seed continued to cause trouble. Seed producers are learning that the harsher methods of breaking up pods do damage by crushing or cracking seed, and that curing seed while still in the pods is just as important in seed production as the curing of plants in production of high-quality tobacco. Greater care in handling, especially in harvesting, curing, cleaning and storage, will eliminate many of the difficulties in the production of seed.

Aside from the conditions mentioned the seed situation in Kentucky, as shown by analyses of official samples, is slightly better than usual.

Educational work with county agents, farmers, teachers, and 4-H groups has been continued and inspectors have increased their work by inspecting a larger number of seed lots and by taking more official samples than in the preceding year. During the fiscal year, July 1, 1944 to June 30, 1945, 5,415 lots of seed were inspected and 542 official samples taken. Analysts spent about 1,120 hours making 1,439

tests on official samples. Enforcement officials passed upon all violations and other irregularities.

**EXPLANATION OF TABLES**

Results of analyses of official samples are shown in tables on the following pages. Table 1 shows the percentages of purity and germination stated on the tags, the presence of an excessive amount of noxious weed seeds, the presence of noxious weed seeds not shown on the tags, irregularities in tags, and absence of tags. The variations allowed in purity, germination, and weed seed per ounce are the same as those published in Kentucky Regulatory Series, Bulletin 4, Revised. Results within the allowed variation are marked with “+” if above, or “—” if below statement on the official tag.

Variations greater than those allowed constitute violations of the Kentucky Seed Law, and such results are printed in bold-face type. In the table, “L” means listed on the tag and “F” means found in our test.

Table 2 shows violations found in samples classified according to wholesale dealers from whom they were purchased.

Table 3 contains a summary to show the kind and number of violations detected.

An examination of the preceding tables shows a comparatively small number of unlawful samples; 97.6 per cent having complied with the law in regard to purity; 94.7 per cent in regard to noxious weed seeds and, omitting corn and tobacco, 92.8 per cent in regard to germination. The low germination of corn and tobacco was probably due to unusual weather conditions, as stated in the introduction to this report, and is not to be taken as a definite trend.

Comparing this report with those of other years, we find the per cent of official samples complying with the seed law in regard to purity (97.6%) the highest since the enactment of the law in 1932. The general trend in all types of violations is satisfactory in that it indicates a desire on the part of all concerned to cooperate in the enforcement of the Seed Law.

Both farmers and seedsmen are to be congratulated on this condition. It is due to the demand by farmers for better seed, and the willingness and ability of the seedsmen to meet this demand.
