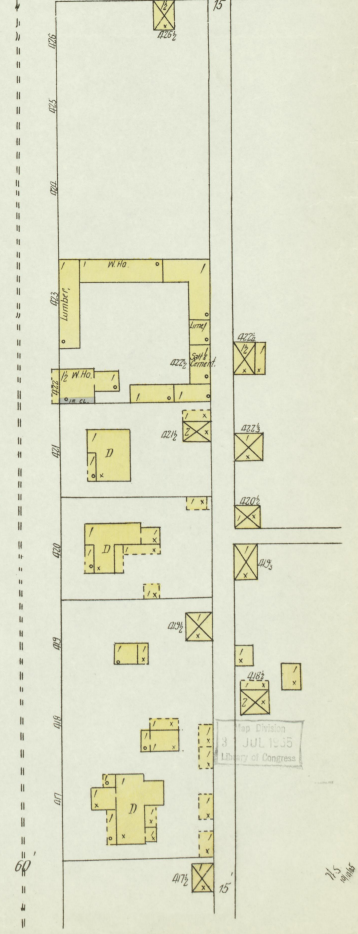
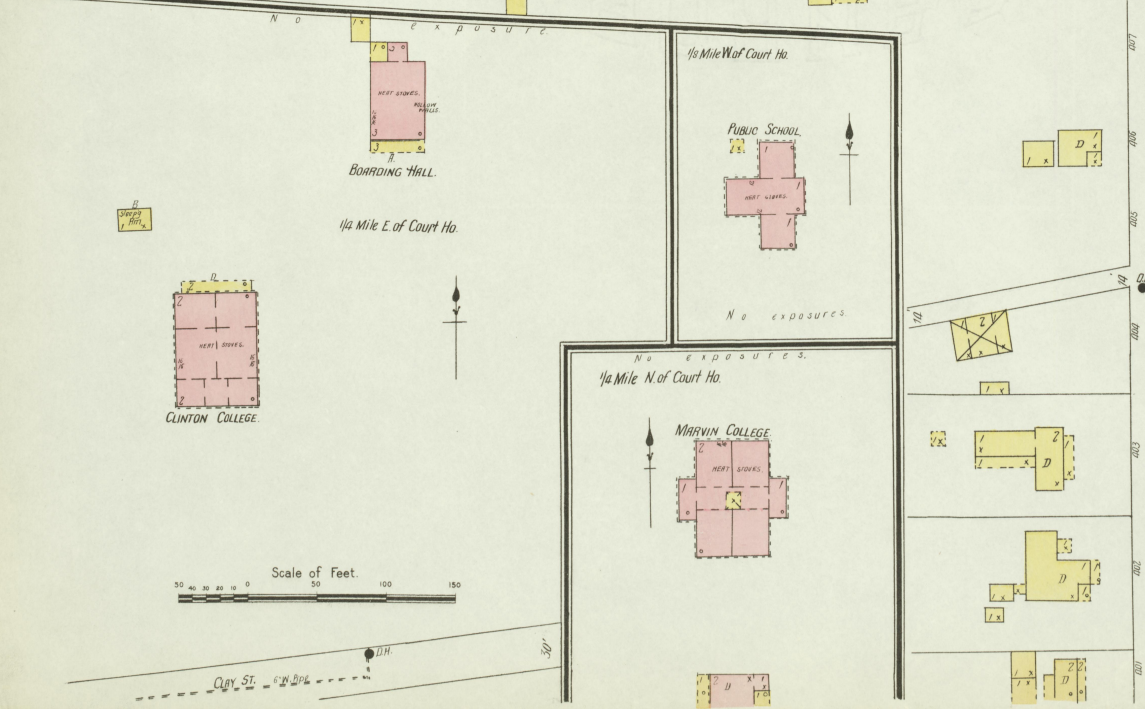
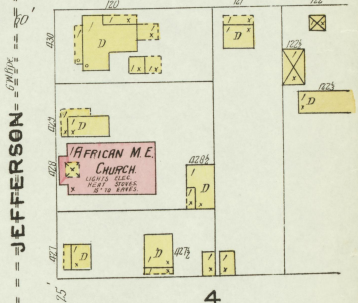
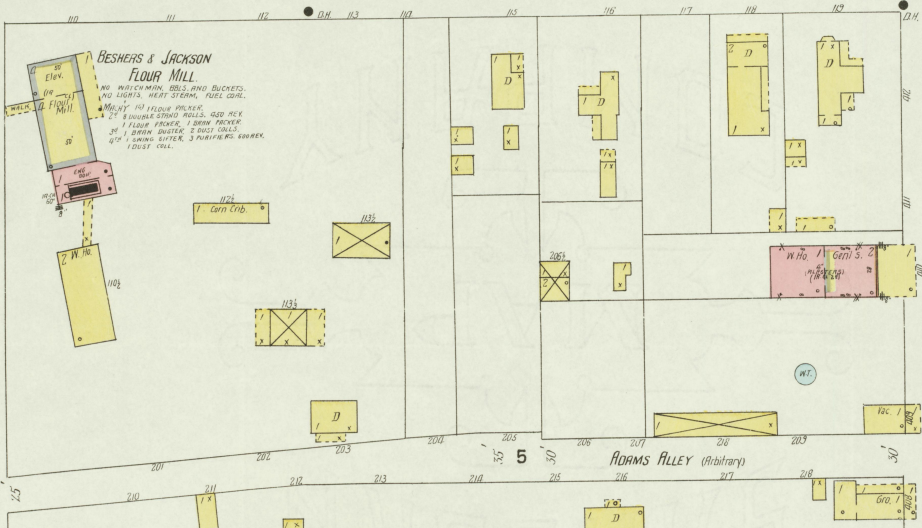
NOTE WATER FACILITIES, GRADIENT AND DIRECTION
