Children's School ends the  
session with June. I  
can not tell what you  
could learn in ~~two months~~  
in any given time, not  
knowing your capacity, but  
if you are in earnest I  
should say that you could  
learn in 2 months enough  
of my system to teach de-  
sign with modelling,  
paper work and paper.  
The children's classes are  
on Tuesdays & Thursdays  
and Saturdays from 3 to 5.  
There would be no expense  
beyond supplying yourself  
with materials for work.  
The Ladies Club costs  
\$30.00 a year and the  
instruction is far better  
there. I do not know

anything about board. I  
once had a great deal of  
trouble, looking up board  
for a lady and finally  
got it for \$10. a week.  
I do not know any German  
families. The best way  
is to go to any quiet hotel  
and devote the first day  
to looking up lodgings.  
It is what I always do in  
London, &c.

The Childrens' school  
consists of pupils from the  
public schools and all is  
paid for by the city.

I have had several  
body teachers come here  
to study the system.
